Venue:

The Championship will be conducted in "Buyant Ukhaa" Sport Complex, Ulaanbaatar, Mongolia, on 8-9 September, 2017.

Accommodations:

The official delegations and referees will be accommodated at "Bayangol" Hotel, Ulaanbaatar, Mongolia. Each mission is responsible for hotel reservation through the Organizing Committee no later than 1 August, 2017 Coaches and athletes will be accommodated at "Baga Bayan" Military Resort/Hotel that is located 35km north of the sport complex.

First aid and medical support will be provided in the venue.

Eligibility

According to the CISM Regulations, volume 2, Policy Manual article 3.19, competitors must be military personnel on active duty with armed forces of their respective countries and must have an up to date military identification card along with passport. There is no age limit for participants. However, the athletes under the age of 18 should be guaranteed by the association of the nation.

Uniforms

National military service dress is mandatory for the opening and the closing ceremonies.





Entry visas

Entry visas for participants will be issued according to the legal visa procedure and arrangements of Mongolia. Visa upon arrival for those guests of the country that does not have Mongolian diplomat mission are requested through the Organizing Committee.

Transportation

The cost of travel will be the responsibility of the participating mission.

The local transportation will be provided by the host country.

National anthems and flags

Each mission is upon arrival requested to bring CD with national anthem and two national flags to deliver to the Organizing Committee.

Weather

The month of September is characterized by *rapidly falling* temperatures, with daily highs decreasing from 22°C to 15°C over the course of the month. Throughout September, the most common forms of precipitation are light rain, thunderstorms, moderate rain, and moderate snow. Therefore, each mission should be consider bring a waterproof jacket during the game.

Rules & Regulations:

Competitions will follow CISM regulations for judo.

Anti-Doping:

Anti-doping tests will be organized in accordance with the latest CISM anti-doping regulations. The number of tests shall be determined by the CISM Anti-doping commission established during the preliminary meeting according to CISM Regulations.





The Administration

Individual weight categories

Male -60kg, -66kg, -73kg, -81kg, -90kg, -100kg, +100kg Female -48kg, -52kg, -57kg, -63kg, -70kg, -78kg, +78kg

Team weight categories

Male -66kg, -73kg, -81kg, -90kg, +90kg Female -52kg, -57kg, -63kg, -70kg, +70kg

Wrestling time: Male four (4) minutes, Female four (4) minutes.

The Participation

Individual Match:

- 1. Each mission has one (1) athlete on each weight, total of fourteen (14) athletes.
- 2. Athletes only compete in their weight category.
- 3. If the mission doesn't have enough athlete on each weight category, they can put 2 athletes in one weight. But, the total athletes are no more than 14.

Team Match:

- 1. Each mission has a team registered maximum of 5 and at least 3 members. Female team as well. In addition, individual athletes and the other athletes can be included in team.
- 2. Athletes can be competing in their weight and over their weight.

Entries

The deadlines for applications are as follows:

Preliminary agreement is no later than 1st June of 2017 (Annex A). Final entry is no later than 1st August of 2017 (Annex B, C, D).





Referee

Each mission sends one referee with a degree of Continental.

If it's required, The Organizing Committee will cover his all expenses during the championship.

The Draw

Drawing (individual & team match) will be conducted on 7 September, 2017. Each mission sends maximum of 2 representatives.

<u>Weigh-in</u>

The weight must be checked in:

Dates: 7 September, 2017 for Individual match.

8 September, 2017 for Team match.

Informal weigh-in: 17:30 - 18:00 hrs. Formal weigh-in: 18:00 -18:30 hrs.

To check Judoqi

Checking Judogi will be conducted according to new rules of IJF. IJF requires judogi with back stickers. A team without back sticker judogi, will be discussed on technical workshop.

Insurance

All athletes MUST have insurance in case of accidents, injuries and loss of luggage etc. The Organizing Committee of the championship will NOT responsible for the insurance.



Jury

Each mission sends one jury with a degree of Continental.

If it's required, Organizing Committee will cover his all expenses during the championship.

The Draw

Drawing (individual & team wrestling) will be conducted on 7th of September 2017. Each mission sends maximum of 2 representatives.

To weight

The weight must be checked in day before the championship.

Dates: 8th of September, 2017 for Individual wrestling.

9th of September, 2017 for Team wrestling.

Informal weight hours: 17:30 - 18:00 hrs. Formal weight hours: 18:00 -18:30 hrs.

To check Judogi

Checking Judogi will be conducted according to new rules of IJF.

IJF requires judogi with back stickers. A team without back sticker judogi, will be discussed on technical workshop.

Insurance

All athletes MUST have insurance in case of accidents, injuries and loss of luggage etc. The Organizing Committee of the championship will NOT responsible for the insurance.





MAZAALAI

Mazaalai – this simple Mongolian world means a Gobi Bear who inhabits in the Gobi desert of Mongolia. No other place on the Earth is home for this rare species of Bear. Its scientific name is Ursus Arctos Gobiensis. It's listed in the Red Book of Mongolia with a status of VERY RARE. They were found in the Desert of Aj Bogd of West Altai mountain ranges in early 1920s. Mazaalai is near extinction & globally threatened bear.

Distribution: Mt. Tost & Nemegt; Hairkhan, Zakhui & Zarman oasis; Segs Tsagaan Bogdo, Shar Khuls & Tumurtei Khokh ranges; Mt.Atas & Inges; Zaraa & Baruun Khar in the trans Altai Gobi Desert.

Habitat: Hilly & rocky areas near the ponds, springs and oasis such as Shar Khuls, Tsagaan Tokhoi & Tsagaan Burgas. Hibernation season is November-March. Average weight is 90-100 kilos & body length is 150 sm & height is 80-92 sm.

Food: leaves & roots of bajuuna (a desert cabbage like plant) and kharmag berry (a desert wild blackberry); desert insects, lizard & carrions of the smaller animals.

Population: 15-20 bears in 1960; 20 bears in 1970; 25-30 bears in 1980 & 30 bears in early 1990. The population fluctuates each year due to the harsh climate and shortage of food, water.

Why the Gobi Bear:

- Because Mazaalai is the only Bear specie that lives wild in the desert on the entire Earth.
- Because Mazaalai is the last preserved Bear specie that does not live in the zoo in other places.
- Because Mazaalai is the same cute and rare bear specie as Panda and Koala who enjoy worldwide care & conservation.
- Because Mazaalai is not only Mongolia's nature given national gift, but he is a treasure of the worldwide wildlife kingdom.
- Because Mazaalai must be available for our future generations to enjoy & learn about this rare animal.

Why are they dying?

- Shortage of food & water in early spring
- Disturbance by livestock & people
- Accidental traps & kills
- Migration for access to water & food
- Competition for food & territory with livestock & human activities.

Dangers. There is no unified understanding and statistics on the bear population yet both in Mongolia & world. Mazaalai is the most less studied & investigated bear on the planet. The best estimated number of this specie could reach between 20-25 heads at present. Under the present circumstances of Mongolia's & worldwide climate changes, Mazaalai faces far more dangers to go extinct than in the previous decades. In this native home, Mongolia, Mazaalai is out of public & private attention. The world does not know this rare bear at all. But every infant & senior citizen in the world see photos & pictures of Pandas & Koalas every day. There is no Mazaalai in the zoo anywhere. Should they die off in Mongolia there will not any change to re-introduce Mazaalai.

Proposed Actions:

The Government:

- establish a national nonprofit organization for scientific research & conservation of Mazaalai.
- announce 27 September as Save Mazaalai National Day for fundraising & public education to raise awareness.
- include mazaalai conservation projects into international conservation program.
- establish regulation for travel & tourism related businesses to donate an amount of proceeding to the foundation.

The immediate projects:

- start population census
- protect & restore oases, ponds & springs in the habitat areas
- do feasibility studies for waterholes & feeding stations projects
- study & implement re-introducing in previous habitat
