GENERAL INFORMATION



1. RULES

The championship will be governed by the regulations as stated in CISM Sailing Regulations in conjunction with ISAF Racing Rules of Sailing (2013-2016), Match Racing Rules Appendix C to RRS 2013-2016 and J/80 Class Rules.

2. **ELIGIBILITY**

- a. All players must be military personnel on full active duty in the Armed Forces of their respective nations (Article, 7.21 of the CISM regulations Page 66).
- b. Players should present a valid military identity card upon registration. (Article, 7.21(D) of the CISM regulations Page 66).
- c. Only active CISM member nations are authorized to participate (Article, 7.23 of the CISM Regulations Page 67).

4. POINT OF ACCESS

- a. Point of arrival: Jinnah International Airport, Karachi, Pakistan.
- b. The cost of the travel to and from the host country Pakistan should be covered by the participating country.
- c. The organizer will ensure local transportation from the point of arrival in the host country to the place of stay.





5. COMPOSITION OF THE MISSION

- a. Team may be mix of males and females.
- b. Additional persons will not be accepted by the organization without explicit written request from the Chief of the concerned country and **UNDER CONDITION** of the written agreement from the Chief of the Pakistan Delegation. Final decision will be on the prerogative of organizers.

6. **WEATHER INFORMATION**

Generally the months of October/November are pleasant with occasional north cold breeze in Karachi and temperature varies between 24 oooC to 31Cduring day time. However at night temperature falls 17C to 23C. The wind conditions during the period can be found on http://www.windfinder.com for Karachi

7. CONDITIONS OF STAY

- a. During the stay from 27 Oct to 02 Nov 16, in Karachi, the participants will be guests of Armed Forces of Pakistan.
- b. Boarding, lodging and all transportation arrangement to commence the championship schedule within this period will be at the expense of the organizers.
- c. Extra expenses (telephone, cocktails, laundry etc) as well as cost of travel to and from Pakistan are to be paid by the participants.
- d. Any cost before the due arrival date or after the departure date must be covered by the participants.
- e. Additional person's expenses will be on participant expenses.

8. **VENUE**

The championship will be organized off Karachi, Pakistan.

9. **Anti-doping**

- a. Anti-Doping tests will be organized in Accordance with the CISM anti-doping regulations, Policy Manual Chapter-IV.
- b. The number of tests to be carried out at the concerned championship will be decided between the Organizer, the CISM Official Representative and the President of the CISM Sailing Sport Committee.





10. UNIFORMS

- a. Service uniform (summer) is required for the opening and closing ceremonies
- b. Sportswear will be usual attire for all activities at the competition site. In the program you will find more information about dress code.

11. **BOAT**

The Boat to be used in the CISM World Military Sailing Championship-2016 will be **J - 80** Class Boat (asymmetrical) for Match Racing Competitions.

12. REQUIRED ITEMS

Every nation shall bring:

- National Anthem recorded on CD / USB.
- National flag 1.0m x 1.5m
- Sailing gear for each participant including certified life vest.

13. CUSTOMS, PASSPORT, VISAS AND HEALTH REGULATIONS

The Missions are responsible for having the necessary customs documents upon arrival at Karachi, Pakistan. For information on immigration requirements, please contact the Pakistan Embassy serving your country.

14. MEDICAL

- a. The Organizer will take care of basic medical support (first aid service) and emergency treatment only during the event.
- b. In case of additional treatment, hospitalization and or routine medical care, participating nations will be responsible for the payment thereof.

15. REGISTRATION FORMS DEADLINES

- a. Preliminary Agreement attached as Appendix 1 must be returned before: 27 July 16
- b. Final Entries attached as **Appendices 2a**, **2b**, **2c** must be returned before: **27 September 2016**

FINAL ENTRY	FINAL ENTRY - COMMITMENT BY THE CHIEF OF MISSION							
Nation:								

The undersigned, Chief of Mission declare that I have read the "CISM Regulations, Chapter VII, Art. 7.30" and moreover understand the following prescriptions:

A. Chief of Mission

- 1. Chiefs of Mission shall be familiar with CISM regulations.
- 2. Missions must not only participate or be present at sports events, they are also required to participate in information conferences on CISM, study days, commemorative and cultural events and ceremonies organized by the host nation.

B. Conduct of a Mission

- 1. The Chief of Mission is responsible for the behavior of his / her team in sports and general discipline. He / She shall ensure that members of his / her mission respect the rules and directives prescribed by CISM and organizers of the championship. The respect of schedules is particularly important as they form the basis for the effective conduct of competitions and ceremonies. Instances of indiscipline or poor sportsmanship will be handled by Championship Officials and may result in the disqualification of individual athletes or teams.
- 2. The Chief of Mission shall also enforce the rules concerning behavior and dress during the ceremonies. He / She plays an important role in promoting the CISM spirit among his/her mission, a spirit represented by friendly attitude towards other Missions, courtesy towards organizers and fair-play in competition. The Mission, that does not wear military uniforms during the opening ceremony of Championship, will not be authorized to take part in the Championship. The Official CISM Representative will communicate this decision.
- 3. In conformity with the Statutes and traditions of CISM, any political or religious action during a CISM event, in particular the dissemination of propaganda documents, pictures, brochures, reviews, etc, is strictly forbidden. Any contravention shall result in the exclusion of the Mission from further competition.
