Venue:

Competitions will be conducted in Lusail Shooting Complex, venue of the 15th Asian Games 2006 and 12th Asian Shooting Championships 2012. It is located 12 km away from the north outskirt of Doha. The facilities are as follows:

- 6 combined shotgun ranges are pointed to the North. They are equipped with Laporte target throwing machines and electronic scoreboards manufactured by Electronica Progetti.
- 300 m range is pointed to the North. 30 shooting lanes are equipped with electronic targets SIUS.
- 50 m range is pointed to the North. 80 shooting lanes are equipped with electronic targets SIUS.
- 25 m range is pointed to the North. 60 shooting lanes are equipped with electronic targets SIUS.

The deadlines for applications are as follows:

Eligibility

According to the CISM Regulations, volume 2, Policy Manual article 3.19 competitors must be military personnel on active duty with the armed forces of their respective country with an up to date military identity card.

Uniforms

National Military service dress is mandatory for the opening and closing ceremony and the closing banquet.

Condition of Stay

The participants will be accommodated in hotels in Doha. Board and housing will be charged to the Organizing Committee from the official day of arrival until the official day of departure. Each mission is responsible for the extra expenses (telephone calls, drinks, laundry etc). It must be paid by the guests. First aid and medical support will be provided in the venue.

Additional personnel will not be accepted without official written permission of the organizers. Any cost before the foreseen arrival date or after the departure date must covered by the participants themselves.

Transportation

The cost of travel will be the responsibility of the participating mission The local transportation will be provided by the host country Points of arrival :-Plane : Hamad International Air Port – Doha Road : Abusamara





Entry visas

Entry visas for participants will be issued according to the legal visa procedure of the State of Qatar. The Visa Request forms should be sent for each participant along with clear photocopy of passport. Please send the passport copies by email. <u>Faxed copies of passports can not be proceeded</u>. Original visas will be kept in Doha International airport. Copies of entry visas for all participants will be forwarded to the Chiefs of the Missions and should be presented on passport control upon arrival.

National anthems and flags

Each Mission is requested to bring CD with national anthem and two national flags to deliver to the Organizing Committee upon arrival.

Firearms and ammunition

The guns will be transported from airport to the stores in the Lusail Shooting Complex and back to the airport at the end of the competitions. It is strictly prohibited to take guns to the hotels for any purpose.

The shotgun and small bore ammunition will be sold during competition days. Detailed list will be published shortly.

Anti-Doping :-

Anti-doping tests will be organized in accordance with the latest CISM anti-doping regulations

The number of tests shall be determined by the CISM Anti-doping commission established during the preliminary meeting according to CISM Regualtions.

Weather

The averages of temperature for late October and beginning of November in Doha are as follows: Min: 21C Max: 32C The precipitation is close to 0.

COMMITMENT BY THE CHIEF OF THE MISSION

Nation:	

The undersigned, Chief of Mission declare that he has read the Article 3.28. of the CISM Policy Manual and moreover understood the following prescriptions:

A. Chief of Mission

- 1. Chiefs of Mission shall be familiar with CISM regulations.
- Missions must not only participate or be present at sports events, they are also required to participate in information conferences on CISM, study days, commemorative and cultural events and ceremonies organized by the host nation.
- B. Conduct of a mission
 - The Chief of Mission is responsible for the behavior of his team in sports and general discipline. He shall ensure that members of his mission respect the rules and directives prescribed by CISM and organizers of the championship. The respect of schedules is particularly important as they form the basis for the effective conduct of competitions and ceremonies. Instances of indiscipline or poor sportsmanship will be handled by Championship officials and may result in the disqualification of individual athletes or teams.
 - 2. The Chief of Mission shall also enforce the rules concerning behavior and dress during the ceremonies. He plays an important role in promoting the CISM spirit among his mission, a spirit represented by friendly attitude towards other missions, courtesy towards organizers and fair-play in competition. The mission, who does not wear military uniforms during the opening ceremony of a Championship, will not be authorised to take part in the Championship. The Official CISM Representative will communicate this decision.
 - 3. In conformity with the Statutes and traditions of CISM, any political or religious action during a CISM event, in particular the dissemination of propaganda documents, pictures, brochures, reviews, etc, is strictly forbidden. Any contravention shall result in the exclusion of the mission from further competitions.
