

### D. Access to the Location of the Competition.


- The travel cost to the host country and respective return will occur under the responsibility of the participating country.
- The organizer will ensure the transportation from Rio de Janeiro International Airport (GIG) to UNIFA Military Hotel on arrival, and return on the departure day, and also daily shuttle during the competitions from UNIFA to Magalhães Bastos BRT (Bus Rapid Transit) Station, that will be connection to sports venues.
- Make sure that International flights arrive/leave from the airport you have chosen

### E. Conditions of Stay

- Board and lodging: accomodations, breakfast and transport to Magalhães Bastos BRT Station and commerce close to hotel.
- Acommodation:
  - o Brazilian Air Force University (UNIFA) Military Hotel Address: Avenida Marechal Fontenele, 1200 Sulacap Rio de Janeiro Zip Code: 21740-002.
  - o Accommodations in UNIFA Military Hotel with capacity by 49 rooms. Only military of the same nationality (same flag) can share the same room.
  - The individual daily cost will be USD\$ 110, including accommodations in UNIFA military hotel, daily breakfast and shuttle transport and must be paid before check-out.





- O Participants have to on Preliminary Agreement, and confirmation of the Flight Information on Final Entry, on which period they want to stay: COMPLETE (2<sup>ND</sup> TO 23<sup>TH</sup> AUG), PARTIAL 1 (2<sup>ND</sup> TO 12<sup>TH</sup> AUG) or PARTIAL 2 (13<sup>TH</sup> TO 23<sup>TH</sup> AUG), according to the availability of Hotel.
- o In case of the CISM member prefers to stay in another hotel rather than UNIFA, he will not have transport support.
- Additional people will not be accepted without official written permission of the Organizers.
- o In case of CISM members wants to bring relatives, all lodging food and transportation will be of his own responsibility.
- Participants who ask for services not covered by the Organizers, such as telephone calls, drinks, laundry etc. must pay the respective extra expenses.
- Participants must cover any costs before and/or after the dates they have previously informed the Organizer.
- The CISM Members must send to Brazilian Military Sport Commission (CDMB) 45 days before the CISM Club Opening Ceremony your copy of the ticket flight to Rio de Janeiro International Airport (GIG).

### F. Presence of Athletes on CISM events

CISM members are responsible to call, to provide transport and to control military athletes of their delegations in protocol events and at the press conferences by CISM Club Rio 2016.

### G. Tickets for competitions

CISM MEMBERS ARE RESPONSIBLE TO GET TICKETS FOR THE COMPETITIONS THEY WANT TO GO. THE ORGANIZING COMMITTEE WILL NOT BE ABLE TO PROVIDE THESE DEMANDS.

### H. Medical Assitance

The organizers will provide only the EMERGENCIAL medical assistance and participants must have your own health assistance, in case of additional medical or dental procedures.

### I. Uniforms

- Uniforms are mandatory for protocols ceremonies, mainly to CISM Club Opening and Closing Ceremonies. Military uniforms (long and short sleeves) and civil suit are required.
- Request the participants' flag and their respective national anthem in a CD version.

### J. Customs and Visa Procedures

Recommend the participants to contact the host country Embassy in their own country.

ANNEX 2b

### FINAL ENTRY - COMMITMENT BY THE CHIEF OF MISSION

COUNTRY:	

The undersigned, Chief of Mission declare that he has read the **CISM Regulations** and moreover understood the following prescriptions:

#### **PARTICIPATION - MILITARY STATUS**

- A. Only military personnel on active duty in Armed Forces may take part in events organized by CISM.
- B. No one may be recalled to active duty in the Armed Forces for the purpose of participating in a CISM event. In the case of an intermittent military service, the athletes regularly recalled may not take part in CISM events, under any circumstances, if more than 18 months have elapsed between this recall and the end of their last call to arms.
- C. Exceptions to the above may be authorized by the General Assembly, upon recommendation of the Board of Directors.
- D. All military participants in a CISM event shall be in possession of proper documentation which signifies active military service of the member nation he represents. The documentation can be:
- 1. A valid military identity card for those athletes who are authorized to present their military identity cards abroad,
- 2. A form of verification (in English and/or French) of military status accompanied by a passport.
- E. By signing the final entry, the Chief of Delegation confirms the military status of the participating athletes. If there are last minute changes in the participation of the athletes, the verification file may be signed by the Participant, but shall be confirmed by the Chief of Delegation by official letter.
- F. If one of these documents is not available, participation is refused.





### **PARTICIPANTS**

### A. Participants

- 1. Participants shall be familiar with CISM regulations.
- 2. Participants must not only participate or be present at sports events, they are also required to participate in commemorative and cultural events and ceremonies organized by the host nation.

### B. Conduct of the participant

- 1. The Participant is responsible for his behavior and general discipline. He shall respect the rules and directives prescribed by CISM and organizers of the event. The respect of schedules is particularly important as they form the basis for the effective conduct of events and ceremonies. Instances of indiscipline or poor sportsmanship will be handled by organizers officials and may result in the disqualification of individual athletes or teams.
- 2. The Participant shall also enforce the rules concerning behavior and dress during the ceremonies. He plays an important role in promoting the CISM spirit among his mission, a spirit represented by friendly attitude towards other missions and courtesy towards organizers. The Participant, who does not wear military uniforms during the opening ceremony of an event, will not be authorised to take part in the rest of event. The organizers officials will communicate this decision.

### ABSENCE OF A PARTICIPANT WITHOUT NOTIFICATION

If a participant which submits a preliminary agreement and/or final entry is absent without notifying the host nation in time, a sanction will be imposed (Regulations Art. 1.12).

#### **RULES OF STAY**

### A. General

The Participants are responsible for their discipline. The participants fall under the jurisdiction of the organizing nation. No one may use his rank to impose his views on sports matters.

### B. Military uniforms

Unless otherwise approved by the organizers, all participants shall wear military uniform during official ceremonies such as the opening and closing ceremonies. Individuals without proper uniform will not be allowed to participate in the event.

### C. Forbidden actions

- 1. In conformity with the statutes and traditions of CISM, any political or religious propaganda during a CISM event, in particular the dissemination of documents, pictures, brochures, reviews, etc. is strictly forbidden.
- 2. Any contravention shall result in the exclusion of the participant from further events and may result in additional sanctions (Regulations Art. 1.12).





### **ACCOMODATIONS**

A. All participants, including those of the host nation, shall be accommodated under the same conditions. If the conditions are in accordance with the CISM norms and standards, including which was established in the Cooperation Agreement, the participant are expected to accept the accommodation provided by the organizing nation.

Any participant that does not accept the accommodations provided by the organizing nation and judged as adequate by the organizer officials will not be allowed to participate in the event.
