OFFICER FROM BRAZILIAN NAVY RECEIVES SOCIETY GRANT TO PRESENT HIS ASTRACT AT THE 4th INTERNATIONAL CONGRESS ON SOLDIERS' PHYSICAL PERFORMANCE

The Lieutenant Commander physiotherapist Thiago Jambo, officer from the Physical Education Center Admiral Adalberto Nunes (CEFAN), Brazilian Navy, had his scientific abstract entitled "Phase one of a musculoskeletal injury prediction model validation: A prospective study in Navy cadets" accepted at the 4th International Congress on Soldiers' Physical Performance 2017 which will be held from 28th of November to 1st December in Melbourne – Australia. He also received one of only six student travel grants that were available to support researchers.

The research consisted of the application of several performance tests in order to identify tests that are associated with the occurrence of musculoskeletal injuries in Navy cadets. In the first phase of the study, 545 cadets from the Brazilian Merchant Marine Academy were assessed, and in the second stage all participants were followed up for 8 months in order to identify cadets with musculoskeletal injury. These findings open up exciting avenues for new research to carry out the screening of future cadets with greater risk of sustaining injuries, especially those related to physical training. Identifying the most likely causes of these musculoskeletal injuries will allow them to be prevented, thus reducing costs and maintaining the Brazilian Navy's military operational for a longer period of time.
