

Minimum Standard for accommodation

- ACCOMMODATIONS – Category 1

Officials will be accommodated in single, double or triple rooms, under the following standards:

Room area	Single	9 m ²
	Double & triple ...	6 m ² per person
Washbasin	1 per room	
Showers, lavatory and urinals ...	1 for 10 people grouped in collective blocks	

- ACCOMMODATIONS – Category 2

Other team members will be accommodated in collective rooms, lodging a **maximum of 10** individuals, according to the following:

Room area	4,5 m ² per person
Washbasin	1 per 4 people grouped in collective blocks
Showers, lavatory and urinals ...	1 per 10 people grouped in collective blocks

- Rooms facilities

All rooms shall be provided with a key, in order to be it possible to lock the doors. The minimum room's fitting comprises:

- a. one bed per person, with mattress, pillow, a pair of sheets, one or several blankets.
- b. one table per room (Officials), one per 6 people (athletes) and one chair per person (both).
- c. locker (1 per person) with padlock closing system. The organizer will not provide the padlock. For the Officials, lockers must contain a closing system. Lockers should contain at least two hangers each one.
- d. trash can, one per room.
- e. two fold curtains or shutters that to make the darkening of the room possible.
- f. collective lighting.
- g. Heating and/or air conditioning system, according to the weather (temperature inside the room should be no less than 19° Celsius and no higher than 30° Celsius).

- Maintenance

- a. For the accommodations-category 1, rooms will be cleaned once a day by a service staff appointed by the organizer;
- b. For the accommodations-category 2, occupants will make their beds and clean their rooms by themselves. The organizer will put the necessary maintenance kit in each room for this purpose, i.e. broom, dustpan, cleaning products etc;
- c. The maintenance of the collective blocks, shared premises (including toilets), corridors and staircases are in charge of the organizer and should be cleaned at least daily;

d. the cleaning/maintenance of the athletes' sport equipment will be under their own responsibilities and expenses.

- Other facilities

The CISM Club must be organized in accordance with the CISM Regulations.

The organizer will ensure the following services are close to the accommodation premises:

- a. bar, sale of alcohol-free drinks;
- b. shopping facilities (close to the bar) where one can buy the following products: food complements, postcards, envelopes, stamps, souvenirs, padlocks, coat hangers, toilet articles, etc...,
- c. public phones;
- d. television room;
- e. games room;
