A. Right to participate in the 2nd CISM World Military Basketball 3x3 Championship

Only CISM active member nations have the right to participate in the **2nd CISM World Military Basketball 3x3 Championship**.

An inactive nation, intending to take part in the event must pay its annual fee before the deadline established by the Organizing Committee of the world military championship for sending the final entry. If it is not done, the delegation will not be able to take part in the event.

B. General Program of the Championship

C. Composition of the Mission

- List the composition of the mission:

- 1 Chief of Mission
- 1 Team Captain
- 1 Coach Male
- 1 Coach Female
- 1 Physician/Masseur/ad libitum
- 1 FIBA International Referee
- 4 Male athletes
- 4 Female athletes

Total: 10 members (14 members if Male and Female teams represents).

- Only military personnel in active duty may participate in the competitions (CISM Regulations, Art. 7.23, item A.).

D. Access to the Location of the Competition.

- The competition will take place in Vilnius, Lithuania, which is 10 minutes away from the Vilnius International Airport.

- The cost of travel to and from the host country will be the responsibility of the participating missions.
- Teams shall arrive at the Vilnius International Airport and Vilnius railway station. Delegations will be welcomed at the Vilnius International Airport and Vilnius railway station by the host site coordinators.
- The organizer will ensure the transportation from the place of arrival in the host country to the place of stay and the transport during the competitions as well.

E. Conditions of Stay

- During their stay the missions are guests of the Lithuanian Armed Forces. Suitable board and lodging will be provided for all participants by the organizers.
- Participants who ask for services not covered by the Organizers, such as telephone calls, drinks, laundry etc. must pay the respective extra expenses.
- Nations arriving before 24th July 2023 and departing after 29th July 2023 must cover any costs and will be responsible for all expenses.
- Additional people will not be accepted without official written permission of the Organizers.
- Medical support for the duration of the event will be provided by the host, which will cover costs for basic emergency treatment only. In case of additional treatment, hospitalization and routine medical care, participating nations will be responsible for the payment thereof.
- All participants must travel with their own inherent medical coverage. Special medical treatment is under the responsibility of the participating nations.

F. Regulations of the Championship.

- The competition will be organized in accordance with the most recent regulations of the Official FIBA 3x3 Basketball Rules April 2020 and CISM Regulations as amended and current as of January 2022. Possible exceptions of the regulations and modifications will be forwarded to all participating nations.
- During the competition official 3x3 ball will be used.

- Only 16 Male and 8 Female teams are accepted. However, a total of 24 teams will be allowed to participate if more or less than 16 men and/or 8 female teams submit agreements on time. Teams will first be prioritized if their country's delegation returns a proper and fully completed preliminary agreement AND final agreement on or before the date(s) listed below. All teams that return agreements on or before the due date will be prioritized equally and those Teams will be selected according CISM basketball 3x3 ranking list and the current CISM basketball regulation. Teams that fail to timely submit agreements may not be able to participate if more than 24 total teams wish to participate. Male teams will play in 4 pools in the qualification round. Female teams in 2 pools.
- As with the 1st CISM 3x3 WMC basketball championship, countries may be allowed to send two (2) teams in either of the genders. However, countries will all be given a chance to have one (1) team competing before any country is allowed to have two (2) teams compete. No substitutions or mixing between teams will be allowed.
- It is planned that all competitions will be played in the indoor basketball hall.

G. Anti-doping

- Anti-Doping tests will be conducted in accordance with the CISM Regulations – Chapter IX, CISM Anti-Doping Rules, the concerned CISM Sports Regulations, the concerned International Federation Rules, and all WADA rules, mainly the World Anti-Doping Code, and the International Standard for Testing.

- The number and type of tests, as well the athletes to be tested shall be determined by the CISM Anti-Doping Commission. These procedures will follow the concerned CISM Test Distribution Plain (TDP).
- In case an athlete has a Therapeutic Use Exemption (TUE), the Chief of Delegation should send this TUE to the CISM GS until 30 days before the Opening Ceremony. This TUE will be submitted to the TUE Commission to analysis and further approval.
- Below are the Organizations Accredited by WADA to carry out the tests during the Championship:
 - Sample Collection Authority (SCA): Anti-Doping Agency of Lithuania.
 - Laboratory: Polish Anti-Doping Laboratory (<https://www.wada-ama.org/en/accredited-laboratories>)

H. Uniforms.

- Military uniforms is mandatory for the opening and closing ceremony, as well as at the Technical Meeting. Summer type of uniforms will be used.
- We will kindly request that your delegations will bring one (1) national flag and anthem on CD or in a memory stick. The anthem can be sent to organizer by email in mp3 format.

I. Customs and Visa Procedures.

- It is highly recommended that each participating nation contacts the embassy of Lithuanian Republic in their respective country for specific information regarding to entry procedures and VISA information into the Lithuania. Failure to do so may cause refused entry into the Lithuania Republic.

J. Weather Conditions

- The average temperatures for the period of the championship in Vilnius: 20°C.
