### A. Right to participate in the 1st CISM Military Jiu-Jitsu Challenge 2026.

- (1) Only CISM active member nations have the right to participate in the 1<sup>st</sup> CISM Military Jiu-Jitsu Challenge (as per CISM Regulations, Article 1.10).
- (2) An inactive nation intending to take part in the event must pay its annual fee right after the deadline of the Preliminary Agreement. If it is not done, the delegation will not be able to take part in the event.
- (3) At the request of the organizing committee, in order to ensure perfect organization, till (12) teams for Men in addition to UAE, and (8) teams for Women CISM active member nations have the right to participate in the 1<sup>st</sup> CISM Military Jiu-Jitsu Challenge 2026, the places will then be allocated to the order of arrival of the applications.
- (4) "Preliminary Agreements" from nations will be ranked according to the order of arrival. The selection of the participating nations will be carried out according to the principle of 3 nations per continent, vacancies will then be allocated according to the order of arrival of the applications.

- (2) No additional member(s) may be included in the mission without prior approval of the Organizers.
- (3) Only military personnel in active duty may participate in the competitions (CISM Regulations, Art. 7.23, item A.).

### D. Access to the Location of the Competition.

- (1) The cost of travel to the point of arrival in UAE will be in responsibility of each participating mission as well as the cost of travel from the point of departure back home.
- (2) The transport from and back to the arrival point (Abu Dhabi / Dubai International Airports to the designated hotel) and the competition arena will be provided by the organizer (LOC).
- (3) Points of arrival:
  - Zayed International Airport
  - Dubai International Airport

### E. Conditions of Stay

- (1) All participants will be accommodated at:

***01<sup>st</sup> to 06<sup>th</sup> November 2026***



- (2) For possible early arrivals before 01<sup>st</sup> November 2026 or late departures after 06<sup>th</sup> November 2026, the missions have to provide their own commercial lodging.
- (3) During their stay in UAE the missions will be guests of The UAE Minister of Defence from 01<sup>st</sup> to 06<sup>th</sup> November 2026.
- (4) The following conditions are applicable:
  - Board and lodging will be provided for all participants, as well as transport for and to all tournament and CISM related events.
  - Participants will be required to pay extra expenses such as telephone calls, laundry, additional food and beverages.
- (5) The UAE Ministry of Defence will provide medical assistance to the mission members including first aid and transport to the hospital during the period of the event. However, the Local Organizing Committee is NOT responsible for:



- Surgical operation or other special treatments.
  - Complicated return transport due to illness/accident or other expenses on account of illness/accident such as compensations, loss of income, etc.
- (6) Any nation the entirely withdraws participation in the CISM Military Jiu-Jitsu Challenge after submitting a Final Entry must provide written notification to the LOC (copying the CISM Secretary General) no later than 15 October 2026.
- (7) An amount of \$400 USD, per day, per person will be charged for administrative costs for any nation that withdraws its participation after submitting the Final Entry. The payment must be made directly to the LOC. Any nation that doesn't inform the LOC of its withdrawal will be obliged to pay additional administrative costs, in accordance with Article 7.23 of the CISM Regulations

**F. Regulations of the Event.**

- (1) During the challenge the following rules will applied:
- The CISM Regulations (Edition December 2025).
  - Ju-Jitsu International Federation ([www.jjif.sport](http://www.jjif.sport))
- (2) Men`s Weight Categories.
- Competitions will be organized in the following weight:  
~ 56 kg, ~ 62 kg, ~ 69 kg, ~ 77 kg, ~ 85 kg, ~ 94kg and ~ 110 kg.
- (3) Women`s Weight Categories.
- Competitions will be organized in the following weight:  
~ 45 kg, ~ 48 kg, ~ 52 kg, ~ 57 kg, ~ 63 kg, ~ 70 kg and ~ 95 kg.
- (4) Belt Divisions or Levels.
- All competitors have the right to participant in the competition regardless of the color of the belt, Unless the technical committee decides otherwise.
- (5) Men`s and Women`s Age Category and Fighting Time.
- The following age categories and fighting times are:

- Competitors will reach the age in the present year (from 1<sup>st</sup> of January to 31<sup>st</sup> December).

### (6) GI and Uniforms.

- The competitors shall wear a good quality GI which must be clean and in good order. They must fit the size of the athlete and the material of the GI must allow a proper grip.
- The competitors must have short fingernails and toenails.
- The competitors are not allowed to wear anything that may injure or endanger anybody.
- GI's should be tailored using cotton or cotton-like fabric. The fabric should not be so thick or hard as to impede an opponent from gripping it.
- The GI should be completely white, royal blue or black. The jacket and pants must be the same color, and the collar must be the same color as the rest of the jacket. It is not allowed for athletes to wear a shirt beneath their GI.
- Athletes competing in the Challenge must have two GI's (one white and one royal blue) to wear in the finals.
- GI's may not have visible tears, be wet or dirty or emit unpleasant odors.
- The GI top should reach the athlete's thigh below the gluteal fold and the sleeves should come to no more than 5 cm from the athlete's wrist when the arm is extended straight parallel to the ground.
- Athletes should use a durable 4 to 5 cm-wide belt colored according to the athlete's rank, with a black tip - except for black belts, where the tip should be white or red. The belt should be worn over the GI top, wrap around the waist twice, and be tied using a double knot tight enough to hold the Gi top closed. Once tied in a double knot, each end of the belt should hang 20 to 30 cm in length.
- Every athlete is entitled to three uniform inspections for approval.
- Athletes are allowed to compete wearing knee or elbow braces but they will have to be wearing them at the time of GI inspection.
- Each country has the right to place its logo or name on the players' GI, according to the places designated for that.

### (7) Prizes and Awards.

- Prizes for the Individual Competitions:  
The organizing committee will present official medals as follows:
  - To the winner of each category: the gold medal and diploma.
  - To the second-placed competitor in each weight category: the silver medal and diploma.
  - To the joint third place competitors in each weight category: the bronze medal and diplomas.
- Other awards may be presented at the option of the organizing committee (commemorative medal, cups, medals, souvenirs etc.).

### G. Anti-doping

- Anti-Doping tests will be conducted in accordance with the CISM Regulations – Chapter IX, CISM Anti-Doping Rules, the concerned CISM Sports Regulations, the concerned International Federation Rules, and all WADA rules, mainly the World Anti-Doping Code, and the International Standard for Testing.

- The number and type of tests, as well the athletes to be tested shall be determined by the CISM Anti-Doping Commission. These procedures will follow the concerned CISM Test Distribution Plain (TDP).

- In case an athlete has a Therapeutic Use Exemption (TUE), the Chief of Delegation should send this TUE to the CISM GS until 30 days before the Opening Ceremony. This TUE will be submitted to the TUE Commission to analysis and further approval.

### H. Uniforms.

(1) Uniforms are mandatory. All participants will be required to wear military dress uniform for Opening and Closing Ceremonies.

(2) Participating Missions are required to bring their nations flag and their respective national anthem in a USB drive version and also the Chief of mission have to check if their respective national anthem, available on the CISM Extranet is up to date and can be used in the event.

### I. Customs and Visa Procedures.

(1) Recommend the participants to contact the UAE Embassy in their own country.

(2) In order to avoid problems with deadlines for granting Visas adopted by different countries and embassies, we recommend that participants contact the UAE Embassy in their own country and schedule an appointment **soon after sending the Preliminary Agreement.**

### J. Weather Conditions

In November, the average temperature in Abu Dhabi is 21°C. With highs of 32°C, you'll need to apply sun cream regularly, seek shade and stay hydrated to be safe in the sun. In the evenings, temperatures dropped to a welcome 20°C.

### **K. Registration Forms Deadlines.**

- a. Preliminary agreement of participation. Annex 1 to be submitted before 1<sup>st</sup> August, 2026.
- b. Final agreement of participation. Annex 2a, 2b and 3 to be submitted no later than 1<sup>st</sup> October 2026. Late submissions may result in denied participation.
- c. Any nation withdrawing from participation after submitting Annex 2a, 2b and Annex 3 and failing to notify the Organizing Committee accordingly will be held responsible for all related costs incurred by the Organizers. (Article E)
- d. A valid and operated mobile phone number and email address are required in the final entry form in case the organizing committee needs to contact you.

**FINAL ENTRY - COMMITMENT BY THE CHIEF OF MISSION**

To be returned before 1<sup>st</sup> October 2026

NATION :

The undersigned, Chief of Mission declare that he has read the **CISM Regulations** and moreover understood the following prescriptions:

**Article 1.10. RIGHTS OF MEMBER NATIONS**

A. Active member nations have the right to:

Be invited to all CISM Championships.

B. Inactive member nations have the same rights as active member nations except that:

They do not participate in any CISM event until they have met their financial obligations.

An inactive nation, intending to take part in the event must pay its annual fee before the deadline established by the Organizing Committee of the world military championship for sending the final entry. If it is not done, the delegation will not be able to take part in the event.

**Article 7.23. PARTICIPATION - MILITARY STATUS**

A. Only military personnel on active duty in Armed Forces may take part in competitions organized by CISM.

B. No one may be recalled to active duty in the Armed Forces for the purpose of participating in a CISM competition. In the case of an intermittent military service, the athletes regularly recalled may not take part in CISM competitions, under any circumstances, if more than 18 months have elapsed between this recall and the end of their last call to arms.

C. Exceptions to the above may be authorized by the General Assembly, upon recommendation of the Board of Directors.

D. All military participants in a CISM event shall be in possession of proper documentation which signifies active military service of the member nation he represents. The documentation can be:

1. a valid military identity card for those athletes who are authorized to present their military identity cards abroad,

2. a form of verification (in English and/or French) of military status accompanied by a passport.

E. By signing the final entry, the Chief of Delegation confirms the military status of the participating athletes. If there are last minute changes in the participation of the athletes, the verification file may be signed by the Chief of Mission, but shall be confirmed by the Chief of Delegation by official letter.

F. If one of these documents is not available, participation is refused.

### **Article 7.32. CHIEF OF MISSION**

#### A. Chief of Mission

1. Chiefs of Mission shall be familiar with CISM regulations.
2. Missions must not only participate or be present at sports events, they are also required to participate in information conferences on CISM, study days, commemorative and cultural events and ceremonies organized by the host nation.

#### B. Conduct of a mission

1. The Chief of Mission is responsible for the behavior of his team in sports and general discipline. He shall ensure that members of his mission respect the rules and directives prescribed by CISM and organizers of the championship. The respect of schedules is particularly important as they form the basis for the effective conduct of competitions and ceremonies.

2. The Chief of Mission shall also enforce the rules concerning behavior and dress during the ceremonies. He plays an important role in promoting the CISM spirit among his mission, a spirit represented by friendly attitude towards other missions, courtesy towards organizers and fair-play in competition.

### **Article 8.6. ABSENCE OF A MISSION WITHOUT NOTIFICATION**

If a mission which submits a preliminary agreement and/or final entry is absent without notifying the host nation in time, a sanction will be imposed (CISM Regulations, Art. 1.12).

### **Article 8.17. RULES OF STAY**

#### A. General

1. The Chiefs of Mission are responsible for the discipline of their mission. The missions fall under the jurisdiction of the organizing nation. During events, all athletes present on the playing fields are equal before the jury, the referees and to themselves. No one may use his rank to impose his views on sports matters.

2. Civilian members of the missions shall conform to the discipline accepted by all other participants.

#### B. Military uniforms

1. Unless otherwise approved by the Official CISM Representative, all participants shall wear military uniform during official ceremonies such as the opening

and closing ceremonies and medal-awarding ceremonies. Individuals without proper uniform will not be allowed to participate in the championship.

2. The presentation of medals takes place, in principle, during the closing ceremony. The presentation of medals may be done in sports uniform, if for organizational reasons it is not possible to wear military uniforms. This is the case e.g. when the presentation immediately follows a championship sports event. Sports uniforms shall respect the corresponding national criteria (training suit, sports shoes, etc.) Displaying the national flag on the podium by the recipient (athlete or team) at a medal awarding ceremony is forbidden. Individuals failing to respect these prescriptions shall not receive their medal(s) during the official ceremonies.

### C. Forbidden actions

1. In conformity with the statutes and traditions of CISM, any political or religious propaganda during a CISM event, in particular the dissemination of documents, pictures, brochures, reviews, etc. is strictly forbidden.

2. Any contravention shall result in the exclusion of the mission from further competition and may result in additional sanctions (Regulations Art. 1.12).

### Article 8.19. ACCOMODATIONS

E. All missions, including those of the host nation, shall be accommodated under the same conditions. If the conditions are in accordance with the CISM norms and standards, the missions are expected to accept the accommodation provided by the organizing nation.

G. Any mission that does not accept the accommodations provided by the organizing nation and judged as adequate by the Official CISM Representative will not be allowed to participate in the championship.
