Thierry Zintz is an emeritus professor of Sports Organisations
Management at the Faculty of Sports Sciences of the Université
catholique de Louvain, Belgium. He was the Dean of the Faculty between

Latour – Jacques Rogge in Management of Sport Organisations at the
same university (2008-2020). He works closely with the Louvain Research
Institute in Management (LouRIM) as a senior researcher and member of
the Center for Research in Entrepreneurial Change and Innovation
Strategies (CRECIS). He was also Vice-President of the Belgian Olympic
and Interfederal Committee from 2001 until 2017 and is Past-President of
the European Observatory of Sport and Employment (EOSE). From May
