1. SCOPE OF DUTIES

- * Only active CISM member nations have the right to participate in the CISM Parachuting Judges Seminar (CISM Regulations, Article 1.10).
- * An inactive nation, intending to take part in the event must pay its annual fee right after the deadline of the Preliminary Agreement of the CISM Parachuting Judges Seminar for sending the final entry. If it is not done, the delegation will not be able to take part in the event.
- * The CISM Parachuting Judges Seminar is dedicated to **Beginner Student** and **Refresher** training participants.
- * The maximum capacity of the seminar will be **20 Beginner Students** and **10 Refreshers**. If the number of participants exceeds the maximum number, the origination, in agreement with the President of CISM Parachuting Committee, will select the participants based on effective necessities (number of the qualified judges in the respective country) and personal qualifications (parachuting background of each candidate).
- * Changes may be made to the above-mentioned schedule. A detailed program will be provided to all participants upon arrival.
- * If required; in coordination with the instructor personnel, one day of accuracy jumping may be planned for the purpose of simulating the accuracy competition and teaching judging duties.

3. REQUIREMENTS

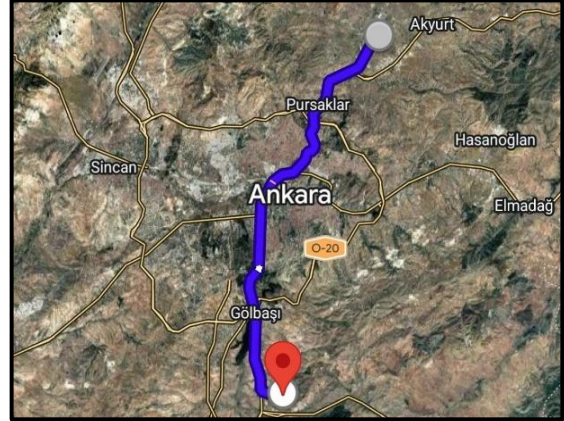
- * A participation fee of 100,00 € for Beginner Students, and 50,00 € for Refreshers, to be paid in cash upon arrival, is required to cover special tutorial expenses. A receipt will be provided upon payment.
- * Adequate knowledge of English as working language (only CISM international licenses and no regional licenses will be issued);
- * Knowledge of parachuting (the Beginner Students have to know what happens in a parachuting competition and preferably they have to possess a background knowledge as sport parachutist and/or as national/civilian parachuting judge);
- * Refreshers must hold a CISM parachuting license
- * Participants must be nominated by their national CISM Delegations;
- * Everyone must bring an operational and silent (no 'beeps') stopwatch capable of recording not less than 50 splits.

4. ACCESS TO THE LOCATION OF THE SEMINAR

- * The venue and accommodation of the seminar is the Special Forces Command located in Ankara, Türkiye.
- * Round-trip travel expenses to and from Türkiye shall be borne by the participating country.
- * The CISM Turkish Delegation shall provide transportation from the point of arrival (Ankara Esenboğa Airport) to the accommodation venue and all transportation required throughout the duration of the seminar.
- * Participants arriving with their own vehicles may proceed directly to the Special Forces Command (The address will be provided upon request). The Organizing Committee shall not provide transportation from other points of arrival.
- * If entry is to be made with military-plated, civilian, or tactically marked vehicles, the necessary arrangements must be made through diplomatic channels (Military Attaché Office).
- * Civilian or military vehicles may be parked within the Special Forces Command premises; however, the vehicle type and license plate information must be declared in advance in the Final Entry Form and confirmed by email to turkishcism@tsk.tr prior to arrival.

*** Beginner Students;**

- Must arrive in Ankara on Monday, 16 November 2026;
- Must vacate their accommodation within the barracks no later than Friday, 27 November 2026.

*** Refreshers;**

- Must arrive in Ankara on Monday, 23 November;
- Must vacate their accommodation within the barracks no later than Friday, 27 November 2026.

* In the event of arrivals at different times, the Organizing Committee will make every effort to arrange appropriate transportation. Please indicate the exact arrival time in the Final Entry Form.

5. CONDITIONS OF STAY

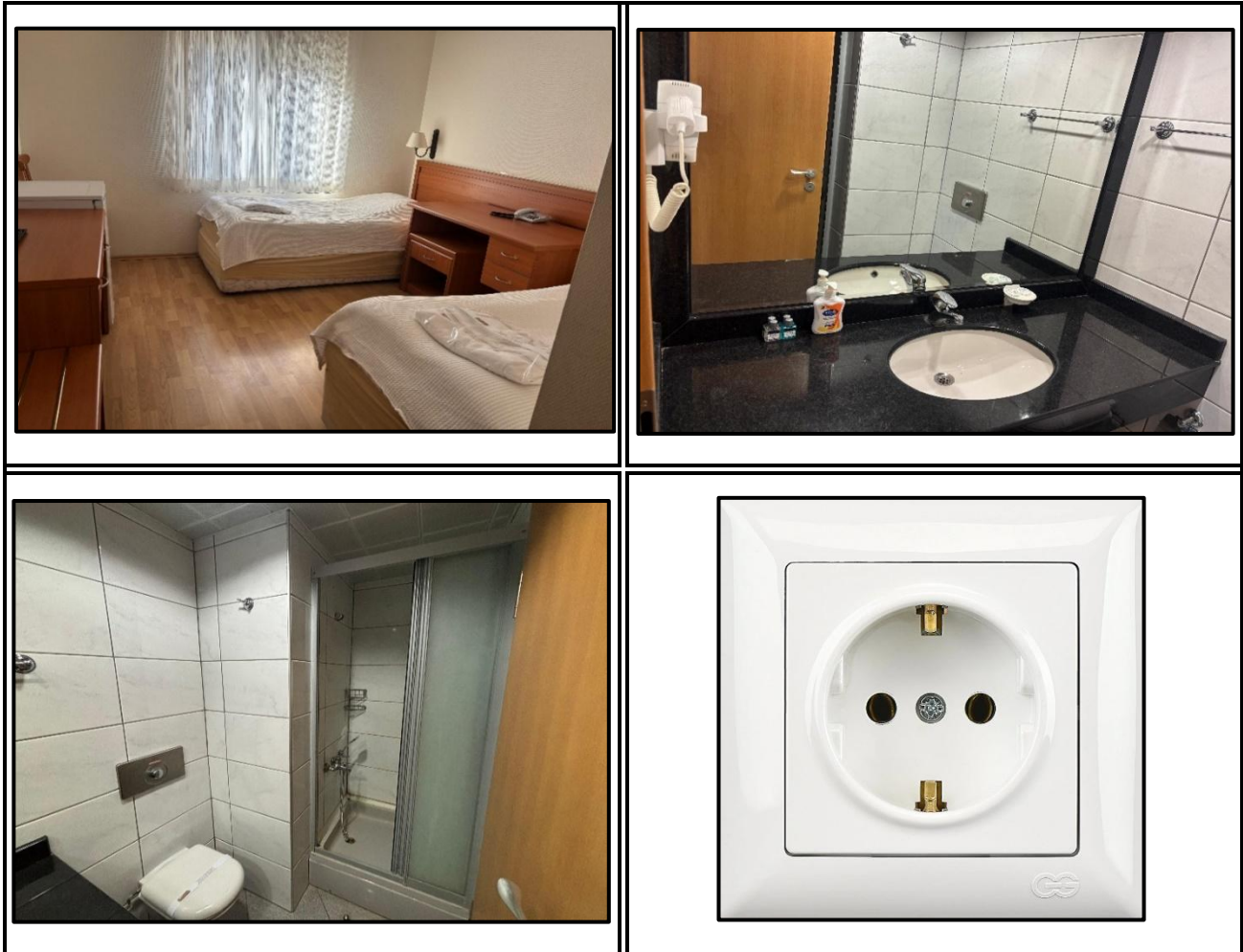
* During their stay in Türkiye, participants will be accommodated at the Special Forces Command in Ankara. Participants are required to comply with the general code of conduct and security regulations in force within the barracks.

* Meals and accommodation will be provided by the Organizing Committee. Accommodation (military-style) will be arranged in rooms for two to four persons.

* Laundry facilities are available in the accommodation area. There is no internet Wi-Fi service within the barracks. It is not possible to provide official military accommodation before or after the invitation dates. All expenses incurred prior to the designated arrival date and/or after the departure date shall be borne by the participants.

* Personal expenses shall be borne by the participants. First aid services will be provided by the Organizing Committee.

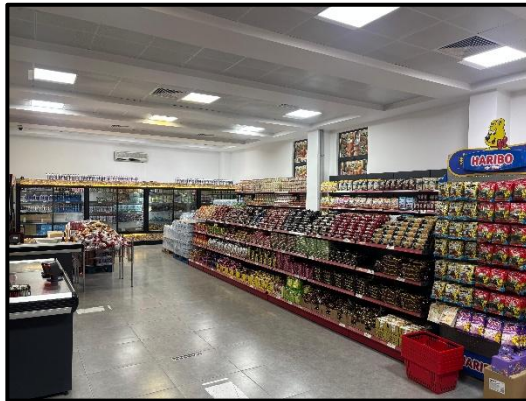
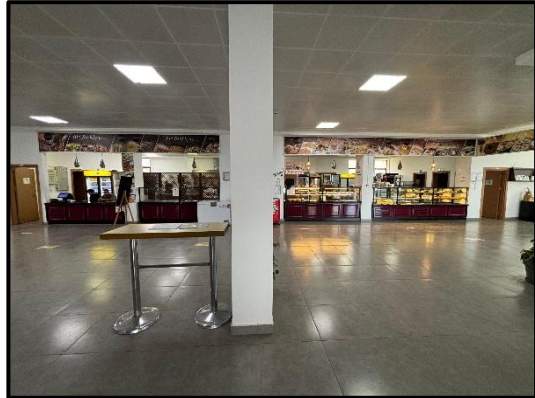
* The use of external accommodation is permitted for Beginner students and/or Refreshers; however, no shuttle service will be provided between the hotel and the barracks, and all expenses related to such accommodation must be paid by the consumer. You are required to indicate your intention to use external accommodation in the Preliminary Entry Form. The selection and reservation of external accommodation are entirely the responsibility of the participant.



6. FOOD AND BEVERAGE

* The menus offer a wide variety; however, participants with special dietary requirements are advised to indicate any food intolerances or religious restrictions in the remarks section of the Final Entry Form.

* A shopping facility is available within the Special Forces Command for the procurement of basic necessities. Only credit cards are accepted at the shopping facility. You are advised to ensure that your credit card is enabled for international transactions.



7. MEDICAL SUPPORT

* The Turkish Armed Forces will coordinate first aid services during training and other planned activities. Any additional medical expenses shall be the responsibility of the participants.

* Participants, particularly those who are not citizens of the European Union, are advised to contact their respective Embassies in Türkiye in order to obtain information regarding precautionary measures to avoid unforeseen medical expenses during their stay in Türkiye.

* As there are no military hospitals in Türkiye, private medical institutions will be utilized if necessary. These services are subject to payment, and delegations are required to have insurance coverage that fully covers all treatment expenses. All costs shall be borne by the participating country.

8. DRESS CODE

- Class A military uniform (militaries) or equivalent civilian attire (civilians) for the opening and closing ceremonies;
- Daily / informal civilian attire: for social activities;
- Working military uniform and/or sports attire: for training purposes.

9. CUSTOMS AND VISA PROCEDURES

* Please contact the Embassy of Türkiye in your country to obtain information regarding passport and visa requirements for entry into Türkiye.

* In order to prevent potential issues arising from visa processing times applied by different countries and embassies, participants are advised to contact the Embassy of Türkiye in their respective countries and schedule an appointment shortly after the Preliminary Agreement has been sent.

10. WEATHER CONDITIONS

In Ankara (Türkiye), temperatures in November are expected to range between 7 and 15 degrees Celsius. The probability of rainfall is 30%.

11. REGISTRATION

* The Preliminary Agreement Form must be returned by email no later than 1 August 2026.

* The Final Entry Form must be returned by email no later than 15 October 2026.

* In the Final Entry Form (a separate form must be completed for each candidate), students must provide a valid and active telephone number and email address to enable the Organizing Committee to contact them.

* A copy of the candidate's Identity Card or Passport (.pdf or .jpg format) must be attached to the Final Entry Form.



12. CURRENCY

* The currency in Türkiye is Turkish Liras. Currency exchange is available at the airport and local banks. It is also possible to withdraw cash from an automated cash point.

- Only debit and credit cards are accepted at the Special Forces Command. Therefore, in order to use your debit/credit cards, they must be active for international use (overseas transactions).
