## A. RIGHT TO PARTICIPATE IN THE 3<sup>RD</sup> CISM WORLD MILITARY ARCHERY CHAMPIONSHIP

- Only CISM active member nations have the right to participate in the 3<sup>rd</sup> CISM World Military Archery Championship (recurve category only).
- Regarding the accommodation capacity (168 12 country of 14 people), applications from nations will be ranked according to their order of arrival. However, additional nation will be welcomed if some teams cannot fulfill the prescribed composition of the delegation and naturally slots are created which is enough to offer for another country (The composition of the team is maximum 14).
- The selection will be studied and finalized by a selection committee, composed of the Local Organizing Committee (LOC), CISM Sport Committee (CSC) Archery and CISM Headquarters (HQ).
- The selection of participants will be carried out according to the principle of prioritizing at least 2 nations per continent. Vacancies will be then allocated according to the order of arrival of the applications.
- An inactive nation, intending to take part in the event must pay its annual fee before the deadline established by the Organizing Committee of the world military championship for sending the final entry. If it is not done, the delegation will not be able to take part in the event.

#### D. ACCESS TO THE LOCATION OF THE COMPETITION.

- The competition will be held at Dhaka, Bangladesh. The delegation shall arrive at Hazrat Shahjalal International Airport (HSIA), Dhaka. The delegation will be received at HSIA by a host nation coordinator/ liaison officer and will be conveyed to the arranged accommodation in Dhaka.
- The cost of travel to and from the host country will be the responsibility of the participating country.
- The organizer will ensure free transportation from HSIA during arrival and to HSIA in departure in Bangladesh and the transportation to/ from the designated site of the competition and accommodation.

#### E. CONDITIONS OF STAY

During the stay in Bangladesh from 25 to 29 February 2024, following conditions are applicable:

- Board, lodging and limited laundry facilities will be provided for all participants as well as transportation from and to all competition and CISM related events.
- Participants are required to pay extra expenses such as telephone calls, extra laundry, additional food and beverages.
- Nations arriving before 25 February 2024 and / or during after departing 29 February 2024 will be responsible for all expenses incurred during the period outside the official competition dates. Lodging can be arranged on request / confirmation on payment basis for extra days.
- In accordance with the Statues and traditions of CISM, any political or religious action during the competition, in particular the dissemination of propaganda documents, pictures, clothing, brochures, criticisms etc is strictly prohibited. Any contravention will result immediate exclusion and departure of such nation.





- Medical emergencies (first aid) will be the responsibility of organizing committee. Organizing committee will provide medical support for the all scheduled competitions. The organizing committee will not be responsible for any advanced medical expenses, including hospital stays, surgical procedure and other medical care beyond first aid.
- All participants must travel with their own inherent medical coverage. Special medical treatment is under the responsibility of the participating nations.
- Additional people will not be accepted without official written permission of the Organizers.
- The competition will be conducted as per Covid 19 guidelines issued by International Archery Federation and Ministry of Health, Bangladesh.

#### F. REGULATIONS OF THE CHAMPIONSHIP

Following rules and regulations are applicable for the participating nations.

- Rules: The CISM Archery Regulations in conjunction with the latest edition of the International Archery Federation Rules and Sports Regulations, the CISM Regulations, CISM Anti-Doping Regulations, as well as local rules as discussed in the Preliminary meeting will apply throughout.
- Eligibility: All athletes must be military personnel on full active service in the Armed forces of respective nations (article 7.23 of the CISM Regulation). Participation of the inactive member nations is not authorized (Article 7.26 of the CISM Regulation). All of the participants are required to present following documents during Preliminary Inquiry:
  - (1) Avalid military identity card for those who are authorized to present their military identity cards abroad.
  - (2) Aform of verification (in English) of military status. (for para-athletes: proof of military status or veteran status).
  - (3) Avalid Passport
- The competition format will be defined considering the number of countries registered to participate in the championship.

#### G. ANTI-DOPING

- Anti-Doping tests will be conducted in accordance with the CISM Regulations Chapter IX, CISM Anti-Doping Rules, the concerned CISM Sports Regulations, the concerned International Federation Rules, and all WADA rules, mainly the World Anti-Doping Code, and the International Standard for Testing.
- The number and type of tests, as well the athletes to be tested shall be determined by the CISM Anti-Doping Commission. These procedures will follow the concerned CISM Test Distribution Plain (TDP).





- In case an athlete has a Therapeutic Use Exemption (TUE), the Chief of Delegation should send this TUE to the CISM GS until 30 days before the Opening Ceremony. This TUE will be submitted to the TUE Commission to analysis and further approval.
- Below are the Organizations Accredited by WADA to carry out the tests during the Championship:
  - (1) Sample Collection Authority (SCA): RADO (https://www.sa-rado.org/AboutUs).
  - (2) Accredited Laboratory: Antidoping Lab Qatar, Doping Analysis Lab.

#### H. UNIFORMS

• Class 'A' Summer Military Uniforms are mandatory for the opening and closing ceremonies and Evening Military Ceremonial for Chief of Mission for plaque exchange ceremony.

#### I. CUSTOMS AND VISA PROCEDURES

- For information regarding the passport and visa for entry into Bangladesh, please contact the Embassy of Bangladesh in respective countries, Make sure that you apply for your visa in time. (immi5@ssd.gov.bd / dgdip@passport.gov.bd / immi2@ssd.gov.bd).
- In order to avoid problems with deadlines for granting Visas adopted by different countries and embassies, we recommend that participants contact the Embassy of Bangladesh in their own country and schedule an appointment soon after sending the Preliminary Agreement.

#### J. WEATHER CONDITIONS

• The weather remains usually warm and dry during the month of February. The average day time temperature lies at 26 degrees C and minimum at night 15 degrees C.

#### K. REGISTRATION FORMS DEADLINES

- Following are the important dates for the registration:
  - (1) Preliminary Agreement (Annex 1) by 24 November 2023.
  - (2) Final Entry (Annex 2a, 2b and Annex 3) by 24 January 2024.
  - (3) A valid and operated phone number and email address are required on final form in case of the organizing needs to contact participating nation.

#### **NOTES:**

• Any nation that withdraws from participation in a competition for which it had sent in the final entry, shall notify the organizers at least 01 month prior to the opening ceremony with copy to CISM HQ. Any nation not so informing the host nation will be subject to disciplinary action (CISM Regulation Article 1.12).





• It is mandatory that each delegation submits with the final entry digital photos of all members wearing military uniform.
