

### **CLOTHING**

No military uniform needed, all activities in sport or casual clothes.

#### **CONDITIONS OF PARTICIPATION**

Only CISM active member nations have the right to participate in CISM events (CISM Regulations, Article 1.10).

19.-23.03.2024

#### REGISTRATION

The event registration will be conducted in two phases.

Preliminary Agreement (until 22.12.2023) and Final Entry (until 05.02.2024). According to CISM rules the name of the judge has to be mentioned at the preliminary agreement. The registration has to be done online via a web platform. You will receive an invitation code to register your mission. Detailed instructions will be provided. If you have any changes after 05.02.2024 you will have the possibility to register them in the Late Replacement Form, also part of the online registration application. Please note that the Final Entry must be submitted in time.

### **CONDITIONS OF STAY**

During their stay (19.-23.2024) in Switzerland the military missions are the guests of the Swiss Armed Forces. The accommodation in Engelberg (Titlis Resort) and the food for the CISM delegations will be paid by the organizer. The accommodation will be arranged for teams registered until 5th of February (Final registration).

However special requests like hotel accommodation have to be paid by the delegation itself. Extra expenses such as fees for telephone calls, laundry services, additional drinks, etc. must be paid by the consumer.


No entry fees will be charged for the CISM competition.

#### TRAVELLING AND TRANSPORTS


Point of entry for all participants is exclusively Engelberg (Titlis Resort). Travelling expenses to Engelberg are at the charge responsibility of the missions.

# **MEDICAL CARE**

The medical service is based on the regional civilian blue light and mountain rescue organization.

**IMPORTANT:** Since Switzerland has no military hospitals, we will make use of private medical facilities if the need arises. These services are not free, and the delegations need to have an insurance which would cover the entire cost of a treatment.

All costs have to be paid by the participating nation.
