The International military Sports Council (CISM) has entrusted the organisation of the **24**TH **CISM World Military Triathlon Championship** to the French Delegation to CISM.

It is my great honour to invite a team representing your country to participate in this event, which will take place in **Brive-la-Gaillarde**, Corrèze department, from May 5th to May 9th, 2023.

The Brive-la-Gaillarde Defence base, the municipality of Brive-la-Gaillarde, the French delegation to the International Military Sports Council (CISM), the National Defence Sports Centre, the French Triathlon Federation, the Gendarmerie school of Tulle and the Brive Triathlon Club will organise this event designated as the **24**th **CISM WMTC #Brive 2023.**

The competition will take place at the Lac du Causse, 15 minutes from Brive. In a green setting, in the Couze valley, born about forty years ago from the desire of local elected officials to make it a place for tourism.

With its 200 landscaped hectares (100 hectares of water and 100 hectares of natural areas), the Lac du Causse site stands out as the calling card of this territory. This locality is an emblematic place for tourism and sport because it regularly hosts national and world triathlon and rowing competitions.

A specific para-triathlon inclusion event for wounded warriors will be held during the championship.

A. Right to Participate in the 24th CISM WMTC #Brive 2023

Regarding the accommodation capacity (300 – 15 full delegations of 20 people), applications from nations will be ranked according to their order of arrival.

The selection will be studied and finalized by a selection committee, composed of the local organizing committee (LOC), CISM Sport Committee (CSC) Triathlon and CISM Headquarters (HQ).

The selection of participants will be carried out according to the principle of prioritizing at least 2 nations per continent. Vacancies will be then allocated according to the order of arrival of the applications.

Only CISM active member nations have the right to participate in the **24**th **CISM WMTC #Brive 2023.**

An inactive nation, intending to take part in the event must pay its annual fee before the deadline established by the Organizing Committee of the world military championship for sending the final entry. If it is not done, the delegation will not be able to take part in the event.

Preliminary agreement list will be sent to CISM HQ in order to verify nation's situation.

Only military personnel in active duty may participate in the competitions (CISM Regulations, Art. 7.23, item A.)

The following medals will be awarded:

- Team medals for Elite men's ans women's (individual race);
- Team medals in the mixed relay;
- Team medals in the mixed Veteran relay.

**Para-triathlon event

Like last year in Spain, this event is above all an inclusion event in application of the CISM motto "Friendship through Sport".

This event is therefore not only for para-triathletes.

Each nation has the possibility of coming with an injured soldier able to practice at least one of the three activities (swimming, cycling, and running).

Mixed international teams will be formed with the possible reinforcement of local triathletes.

The presence in the delegations of para-triathletes able to carry out the entire event may give rise to a specific classification according to the categories of disability (standing, sitting, post-traumatic syndrome).

All of these elements will be specified during the technical meeting.

D. Access to Competition Site.

The travel cost to the host country and the return thereof will be under the sole responsibility of the participating country.

The LOC will ensure transportation from the place of arrival in the host country to the place of stay and transport during the competitions as well.

E. Conditions of Stay

During their stay from May 05 to 09, 2023 in Brive-la-Gaillarde, the participants are the guests of the French Army.

Participants who ask for services not covered by the Organizers, such as telephone calls, drinks, laundry etc. must pay the additional expenses.

Participants must cover any costs before and/or after the dates they have previously informed the organizer of. Additional expenses related to an arrival before the official day or a delayed departure must be paid by the participants.

All delegations will be housed in the nautical base of Lake du Causse in Chasteaux (see photos in the appendix). Heads of mission and VIPs can be accommodated in hotels or lodges as needed.

The organizers will provide medical support and emergency care during the championship. In the event of further treatment, hospitalization or ordinary medical care, the participating nations will be responsible for paying the costs.

F. Regulations of the Championship.

The triathlon will consist of 7 races defined by category Elite Men, Elite Women, Senior Men, Senior Women, Elite Mixed Relay, Senior Mixed Relay and Paratriathlon (wounded personnel).





Anti-doping

Anti-Doping tests will be conducted in accordance with the CISM Anti-Doping Symbol CISM Regulations - Chapter IX, CISM Anti-Doping Rules, the concerned CISM Sports Regulations, the concerned International Federation Rules, and all WADA rules. mainly the World Anti-Doping Code, and the International Standard for Testing.

The number and type of tests, as well the athletes to be tested shall be determined by the CISM Anti-Doping Commission. These procedures will follow the concerned CISM Test Distribution Plain (TDP).



In case an athlete has a Therapeutic Use Exemption (TUE), the Chief of Delegation should send this TUE to the CISM GS until 30 days before the Opening Ceremony.

This TUE will be submitted to the TUE Commission to analysis and further approval.

I. Customs and Visa Procedures.

The participating nations are responsible for all the procedures allowing them to access France.

Receiving your preliminary agreement, French delegation will inform the French Defence Mission at the embassy responsible for your nation.

J. Weather Conditions

The temperature in Brive-la-Gaillarde at the beginning of May is between 9°C to 12°C in the morning and 18°C to 25°C in the afternoon.

K. Registration Forms Deadlines.

The preliminary agreement (appendix 1) must be returned before Febuary 5th, 2023.

The final agreement (appendix 2 and 3) must be returned before April 5th, 2023.

The undersigned, Chief of Mission declare that he has read the CISM Regulations to the 24th CISM World Military Triathlon Championship #Brive 2023 and moreover understood the following prescriptions:

Article 1.10. RIGHTS OF MEMBER NATIONS

A. Active member nations have the right to:

Be invited to all CISM Championships.

B. Inactive member nations have the same rights as active member nations except that:

They do not participate in any CISM event until they have met their financial obligations.

An inactive nation, intending to take part in the event must pay its annual fee before the deadline established by the Organizing Committee of the world military championship for sending the final entry. If it is not done, the delegation will not be able to take part in the event.

Article 7.23. PARTICIPATION - MILITARY STATUS

- A. Only military personnel on active duty in Armed Forces may take part in competitions organized by CISM.
- B. No one may be recalled to active duty in the Armed Forces for the purpose of participating in a CISM competition. In the case of an intermittent military service, the athletes regularly recalled may not take part in CISM competitions, under any circumstances, if more than 18 months have elapsed between this recall and the end of their last call to arms.
- C. Exceptions to the above may be authorized by the General Assembly, upon recommendation of the Board of Directors.





- D. All military participants in a CISM event shall be in possession of proper documentation which signifies active military service of the member nation he represents. The documentation can be:
- 1. a valid military identity card for those athletes who are authorized to present their military identity cards abroad,
- 2. a form of verification (in English and/or French) of military status accompanied by a passport.
- E. By signing the final entry, the Chief of Delegation confirms the military status of the participating athletes. If there are last minute changes in the participation of the athletes, the verification file may be signed by the Chief of Mission, but shall be confirmed by the Chief of Delegation by official letter.
- F. If one of these documents is not available, participation is refused.

Article 7.32. CHIEF OF MISSION

A. Chief of Mission

- 1. Chiefs of Mission shall be familiar with CISM regulations.
- 2. Missions must not only participate or be present at sports events, they are also required to participate in information conferences on CISM, study days, commemorative and cultural events and ceremonies organized by the host nation.

B. Conduct of a mission

- 1. The Chief of Mission is responsible for the behavior of his team in sports and general discipline. He shall ensure that members of his mission respect the rules and directives prescribed by CISM and organizers of the championship. The respect of schedules is particularly important as they form the basis for the effective conduct of competitions and ceremonies.
- 2. The Chief of Mission shall also enforce the rules concerning behavior and dress during the ceremonies. He plays an important role in promoting the CISM spirit among his mission, a spirit represented by friendly attitude towards other missions, courtesy towards organizers and fair-play in competition.

Article 8.6. ABSENCE OF A MISSION WITHOUT NOTIFICATION

If a mission which submits a preliminary agreement and/or final entry is absent without notifying the host nation in time, a sanction will be imposed (CISM Regulations, Art. 1.12).

Article 8.17. RULES OF STAY

A. General

1. The Chiefs of Mission are responsible for the discipline of their mission. The missions fall under the jurisdiction of the organizing nation. During events, all athletes present on the playing fields are equal before the jury, the referees and to themselves. No one may use his rank to impose his views on sports matters.





2. Civilian members of the missions shall conform to the discipline accepted by all other participants.

B. Military uniforms

- 1. Unless otherwise approved by the Official CISM Representative, all participants shall wear military uniform during official ceremonies such as the opening and closing ceremonies and medal-awarding ceremonies. Individuals without proper uniform will not be allowed to participate in the championship.
- 2. The presentation of medals takes place, in principle, during the closing ceremony. The presentation of medals may be done in sports uniform, if for organizational reasons it is not possible to wear military uniforms. This is the case when the presentation immediately follows a championship sports event. Sports uniforms shall respect the corresponding national criteria (training suit, sports shoes, etc.)

Displaying the national flag on the podium by the recipient (athlete or team) at a medal awarding ceremony is forbidden. Individuals failing to respect these prescriptions shall not receive their medal(s) during the official ceremonies.

C. Forbidden actions

- 1. In conformity with the statutes and traditions of CISM, any political or religious propaganda during a CISM event, in particular the dissemination of documents, pictures, brochures, reviews, etc. is strictly forbidden.
- 2. Any contravention shall result in the exclusion of the mission from further competition and may result in additional sanctions (Regulations Art. 1.12).

Article 8.19. ACCOMODATIONS

- E. All missions, including those of the host nation, shall be accommodated under the same conditions. If the conditions are in accordance with the CISM norms and standards, the missions are expected to accept the accommodation provided by the organizing nation.
- G. (...) Any mission that does not accept the accommodations provided by the organizing nation and judged as adequate by the Official CISM Representative will not be allowed to participate in the championship.



FURTHER INFORMATIONS

ACCOMMODATION FOCUSED ON SUSTAINABILITY

All of the accommodation for participants (excluding the Chief of Mission) will be located within the nautical base itself, around the Causse Lake.

The accommodations can accommodate a maximum of 300 people and are defined as follows:

- o 19 gites with 5 places including 1 bathroom or shower room, 2 bedrooms with 2 beds each and 1 living room / kitchnette with 1 double sofa bed.
- o 6 gites with 4 places including 1 bathroom, 1 bedroom with 1 bed, 1 hallway with 2 beds and 1 living room / kitchnette with 1 double sofa bed.
- o 20 wooden chalets with 4 places including 1 bathroom, 1 bedroom with 1 bed, 1 bedroom with 2 beds and 1 sofa bed.
- o 5 mobile homes with 6 places including 1 bathroom, 1 bedroom with 1 bed, 2 bedrooms with 2 beds and 1 double sofa bed.
- o 7 mobile homes with 4 places including 1 bathroom, 1 bedroom with 1 bed, 1 bedroom with 2 beds and 1 double sofa bed.
- o 15 wooden eco-lodges with 3 places including 1 bedroom with 2 beds and 1 double sofa bed.
 - o Finally, for those coming by motorhome, 58 pitches.

Accommodation for officials and Chiefs of Delegation will be organised in hotels and lodges around the lake.

TRAVELS FOCUSED ON SUSTAINABILITY

All vehicle travel will be done, as soon as possible, by electric or hybrid vehicle.

Competitors will travel from the Causse Lake to Brive, round trip, by bus (electric if the town of Brive-la-Gaillarde has the capacity to provide them) or by traditional bus.

CISM WORLD MILITARY TRIATHLON CHAMPIONSHIP

The World Military Triathlon Championship will take place on a course defined around the Causse Lake according to the following procedures.

The key word for this day of events will be safety and a special effort will be made to allow athletes to run their event with complete peace of mind.

1- Elite Men's and Women's Race:

- 1.5 kms of swimming in the Causse Lake.
- 40 kms of cycling on the departmental roads near the lake by chaining 4 loops of 10 kms each.
- o 10 km of running from the bike park around the Causse Lake

2 - Senior Men's and Women's Race:

- 1.5 kms of swimming in the Causse Lake.
- 40 kms of cycling on the departmental roads near the lake by with 4 loops of 10 kms each.
- o 10 km of running from the bike park around the Causse Lake

3 - Mixed Elite and Senior Relay Race:

- o 300m swimming in the Causse Lake.
- o 6 kms of cycling around the Causse Lake.
- o 2 km on foot around the Causse Lake.

4 - Wounded Race

- o 400 m of swimming in the Causse Lake.
- o 10 kms of cycling around the Causse Lake.
- 2.5 km on foot around the Causse Lake.

Like last year in Spain, this event is above all an inclusive event in application of the CISM motto "Friendship through Sport".

This event is therefore not only for para-triathletes.

Each nation has the possibility of coming with an injured soldier able to practice at least one of the three activities (swimming, cycling or running).

Mixed international teams will be formed with the possible reinforcement of local triathletes.

The presence in the delegations of para-triathletes able to carry out the entire event may give rise to a specific classification according to the categories of disability (standing, sitting, post-traumatic syndrome).

All of these elements will be specified during the technical meeting.
