Only CISM active member nations have the right to participate in CISM Events (CISM Regulations, Article 1.10)

An inactive nation, intending to take part in the event must pay its annual fee before the deadline established by the Organizing Committee for sending the final entry. If it is not done, the delegation will not be able to take part in the event.





A. COMPOSITION OF THE MISSION

The seminar is dedicated to:

- Beginner Students;
- Refreshers.

The maximum capacity of the seminar will be 20 Beginner Students and 10 Refreshers.

If the number of participants exceeds the maximum number, the organisation, in agreement with the President of CISM Parachuting Committee, will select the participants based on effective necessities (number of the qualified judges in the respective country) and personal qualifications (parachuting background of each candidate).

B. GENERAL PROGRAM OF THE SEMINAR

Note: This program is not exhaustive; a detailed program will be provided to all participants upon arrival.

C. REQUIREMENTS

The requirements to take part in the seminar are:

- a participation fee of 100,00 € for Beginner Students, and 50,00 € for Refreshers, to be paid cash upon arrival, to cover special tutorial expenses. A receipt will be provided upon payment;
- adequate knowledge of English as working language (only CISM international licenses and no regional licenses will be issued);
- knowledge of parachuting (the Beginner Students have to know what happens in a parachuting competition and preferably they have to possess a background knowledge as sport parachutist and/or as national/civilian parachuting judge);
- refreshers must hold a CISM parachuting license;
- participants must be nominated by their national CISM Delegations;
- everyone must bring an operational and silent (no 'beeps') stopwatch capable to record not less than 50 splits.





D. ACCESS TO THE LOCATION OF THE SEMINAR

The location and accommodation of the seminar is the Parachuting Training Center of the Italian Army, in Pisa (C.A.PAR, Italy). Travel expenses to and from Italy will be under the responsibility of each participating country.

The organization of the seminar will provide:

- transportation from and to the point of arrival [Pisa International Airport (PSA) or Pisa Railway Central Station] to the location of the seminar (if requested);
- transportation during the seminar;

Beginner Students must:

- arrive to Pisa on Mon 29th Apr;
- leave their accommodation at the Barracks no later than Fri 9th May.

Refreshers must:

- arrive to Pisa on Tue 06th Mav:
- leave their accommodation at the Barracks no later than Fri 9th May.

In case of arrival at different timing, the organisation committee will do its best to ensure the adequate transport. Please report exactly your arrival time on the Final Entry Form.

Civilian or military vehicles can be parked inside the Parachuting Training Center, but the type of vehicle and the plates must be previously reported on the Final Entry Form and confirmed before arrival by e-mail to dtras@cepara.esercito.difesa.it.

E. CONDITIONS OF STAY

During their stay in Italy the students will be guests of the Italian Army at the Parachuting Training Center in Pisa (Italy). The participants have to respect the normal rules of conduct and safety regulations requested inside the Barracks. Board and lodging will be provided by the organisation. The accommodation (military style) will be offered in double and triple rooms.

There are coin-operated laundries near the Barracks. There is not Internet WIFI service inside the Barracks. It is not possible to provide official military accommodation before and after the invitation dates. Any costs before the established date of arrival and/or after the date of departure, must be covered by the participants.

F. FOOD AND BEVERAGE

Tap water is safe to drink. Menus are widely varied, but participants with special needs are encouraged to indicate particular food intolerances or religious limitations in the notes on the Final Entry Form.

G. MEDICAL SUPPORT

Italian Army will take care to coordinate the first aid during the training and the other planned events. Further costs for medical support are at the expenses of the participants.

In particular, for non-European Union citizens it is advisable to contact their respective Embassy in Italy to gather information about the best precautionary procedures to adopt preemptively to avoid incurring in any unexpected medical expenses while in Italy.

H. DRESS CODE

- military uniform: for opening and closing event;

- casual/informal dress: for social events;

- working uniforms and/or sports clothing: for training.





I. EXTERNAL ACCOMMODATION

For Beginner and/or Refresher is possible to use external accommodations, but there will be no shuttle service from/to the hotel and the Barracks, and the expense for such lodging must be paid by the consumer. Please specify your intention to use external accommodation in the Preliminary Agreement. Both selection and booking of external accommodations is a consumer's responsibility.

J. CUSTOMS AND VISA PROCEDURES

If you need Visa to enter Italy, please contact the Embassy of Italy in your country, or your respective Embassy in Italy.

K. WEATHER CONDITIONS

The temperature in Pisa (Italy) in April-May is expected to be 13 to 22 degrees Celsius. The probability of rain is 30%.

L. REGISTRATION

The Preliminary Agreement must be returned by e-mail as soon as possible.

The Final Entry Form must be returned by e-mail **before March 31st 2025**.

On the Final Entry Form (please fill one form for each candidate) the students have to indicate valid and operated phone number and e-mail address, in case the organisation needs to contact them

A copy of the candidate's ID Card or Passport (.pdf or .jpg) must be attached to the Final Entry Form.
