

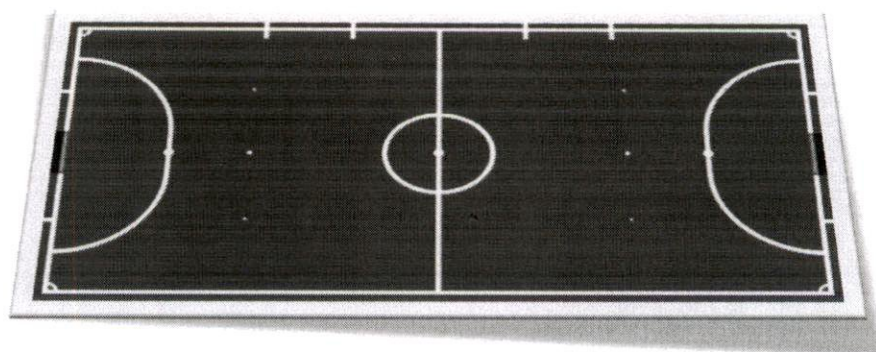

Only military personnel in active duty can participate in the competition (*see CISM Regulation, art 7.23*). Additional mission members will not be accepted by the organizer.

D. Access to the Location of the Competition

All Participants arriving in Montenegro will be welcomed at the barracks in Kolašin or at the International Airport in Podgorica. The organizer cannot provide transportation from any other points of arrival. The cost of travel to and from the point of arrival will be the responsibility of the participating country.

The organizer will ensure the transportation from the point of arrival to the "Breza" Barracks in Kolašin and local transportation during the competitions as well.

A detailed map and directions will be sent upon request.

E. Conditions of Stay

During their stay in Montenegro, the missions will be guests of the Armed Forces of Montenegro from 13 to 18 October 2025. Full board and lodging will be at the expense of the organizer. Accommodation will be provided by the Armed Forces of Montenegro in the "Breza" Barracks in Kolašin.

Extra expenses, including telephone, laundry and drinks, are to be paid by the consumers.

Any costs incurred due to early arrival and/or late departure will be covered by the participants.

Additional persons will not be accepted without official written permission from the organizer.

The organizer will take care of the first aid medical assistance during the competition. Any further medical support costs (hospitalization, surgical operations, special treatments, repatriation in case of illness or accidents) are to be covered by the participants.

F. Uniforms

Uniform: Service dress uniform at Opening and Closing Ceremonies (mandatory).

Training clothes: To be worn during competitions.

Leisure: To be worn during free time.

We kindly ask all participants to bring a CD containing their national anthem and a national flag sized: 1 x 1.5 m, 2 x 1.5 m.

H. Weather Conditions.

Average temperatures in northern Montenegro in October range between 5° C (night) and 20° C (day).

ANNEX 3

FINAL ENTRY – COMMITMENT BY THE CHIEF OF MISSION

NATION:

The undersigned Chief of Mission declares that he has read the CISM Regulations and understood the following prescriptions:

A. Chief of mission

1. Chiefs of Mission shall be familiar with CISM regulations.
2. Mission must not only participate or be present at sport events, but are also required to participate in information conferences on CISM, study days, commemorative and cultural events and ceremonies organized by the host nation.

B. Conduct of a mission

1. The Chief of Mission is responsible for the behavior of his team in sports and general discipline. He shall ensure that members of his mission respect the rules and directives prescribed by CISM and the organizers of the championship. Adherence to schedules is particularly important, as they form the basis for the effective conduct of competitions and ceremonies. Instances of indiscipline or poor sportsmanship will be handled by Championship officials and may result in the disqualification of individual athletes or teams.
2. The Chief of Mission shall also enforce the rules concerning behavior and dress during the ceremonies. He plays an important role in promoting the CISM spirit among his mission, a spirit represented by a friendly attitude towards other missions, courtesy towards organizers and fair-play in competition. Missions whose members do not wear military uniforms during the opening ceremony of the Championship will not be authorized to take part in the Championship. The Official CISM Representative will communicate this decision.
3. In conformity with the Statutes and traditions of CISM, any political or religious action during a CISM event, in particular the dissemination of propaganda



documents, pictures, brochures, reviews, etc. is strictly forbidden. Any contravention shall result in the exclusion of the mission from further competition.

ANNEX 4

REGULATIONS OF THE CHAMPIONSHIP

1. Regulations of the Championship

The events will be governed by CISM and FIFA regulations.

The Futsal competitions shall be subject to the Futsal Rules and Regulations of the FIFA (Futsal Rules of the Game – available at: <http://www.fifa.com>), with the English text being binding. Delegations shall undertake to comply with the FIFA Equipment Regulations in force.

2. Organization

The Organizing Committee will be responsible for the Futsal competitions of the 15th CISM Futsal Cup for Peace 2025. The opening and closing ceremonies will be organized in accordance to CISM Regulations.

3. Venues and times

The Organizing Committee will determine the venues and times of the Futsal competitions and the teams will be notified accordingly.

The Organizing Committee is authorized to change the venues and times of the competitions. These decisions will be final.

4. Equipment

Participating Missions are not allowed to display political, religious, commercial or personal messages, in any language or form, on their playing or team kits, equipment, or body during their time spent in the halls or any other areas where accreditation is required for access.

The futsal balls for the 15th CISM Futsal Cup for Peace 2025 shall be selected by the Organizing Committee according to FIFA regulations. Each team will receive three (3) match balls for training purposes.

For matches, each participating mission must bring at least two sets of team uniforms in different colors for the competition.



5. Disciplinary Matters

Disciplinary incidents will be dealt with in compliance with CISM Regulations. The Participating Missions and their players agree to comply with the CISM's statutes and regulations; FIFA's Futsal Laws of the Games, the WADA's doping regulations, equipment regulations and commercial regulations. They also agree to comply with all further CISM and FIFA guidelines, circulars, directives and decisions applicable to the 15th CISM Futsal Cup for Peace 2025.

The players notably agree to:

- respect the spirit of fair play and non-violence.
- behave in accordance with their status as military personnel.

Players sent off from the field of play will automatically be suspended as follows:

- a. Serious foul play – suspended for the next game.
- b. Violent conduct - suspended for the next 2 games.
- c. Spitting at an opponent or any other person - suspended for the next 2 games.
- d. Denying an obvious goal scoring opportunity by deliberately handling the ball – suspended for the next game.
- e. Denying an obvious goal scoring opportunity to an opponent moving towards the player's goal by an offence punishable by a free kick or a penalty kick - suspended for the next game.
- f. Using offensive, insulting or abusive language and/or gestures - suspended for the next 2 games.
- g. Receiving a second caution in the same match - suspended for the next game.
- h. A player reported by the referee for misconduct after the match - suspended for the next 2 games.

A player who has been sent off must leave the vicinity of the field of play and the technical area.

6. Protests

- a. For the purpose of these regulations, protests are objections of any kind related to events or matters that have a direct effect on matches, including but not limited to the condition of and markings on the pitch, accessory match equipment, eligibility of players, venue installations and futsal balls.
- b. Unless otherwise stipulated in this article, protests shall be submitted in writing to the Technical Jury within two (2) hours of the conclusion of the match in question and immediately followed up by a full written report, including a copy of the original protest, submitted to the Montenegrin Delegation to CISM. Protests failing to meet these requirements will be disregarded.



- c. Protests regarding the eligibility of players nominated for matches shall be submitted in writing to Organizing Committee no later than two (2) hours before the first match of the 15th CISM Futsal Cup for Peace 2025.
- d. Protests regarding the condition of the pitch, its surroundings, markings or accessory items (e.g. goals or futsal balls) shall be made in writing to the referee before the start of the match by the head of mission of the protesting team. If the pitch becomes unplayable during a match, the captain of the protesting team shall immediately lodge a protest with the referee in the presence of the captain of the opposing team. The protest shall then be confirmed in writing to the President of the Technical Jury, by the head of mission no later than two (2) hours after the match.
- e. It is not possible to protest against referees' decisions.

7. System of competition

Competitions of 15th CISM Futsal Cup for Peace 2025 will be realized as follows:

- a. The 6 teams will be divided into 2 groups:
 - The heads of each group will be the host nations and the last champion.
 - The competitions between groups will be played on a league basis of a single round robin.
- A maximum of two matches per day will be allowed, with a minimum interval of 1 hour between them.
- The winner of each game will be awarded two points, the loser no points, and in case of a draw, each team will be awarded one point.
- Ranking shall be determined as follows:
 - 1. Greater number of points obtained;
 - 2. Goal difference in all matches;
 - 3. Greater number of goals scored in all matches;
- If two or more teams are equal on the basis of the above three criteria, their place shall be determined as follows:
 - 1. Greater number of points obtained in the matches between the teams concerned
 - 2. Goal difference resulting from the matches between the teams concerned;
 - 3. Greater number of goals scored in the matches between the teams concerned;
 - 4. Drawing lots by the Organizing Committee.
- b. The semi-final games will be played on the Cross system, i.e. the team placed first in Group A will play against the team placed second in Group B and the team placed second in Group A will play against the team placed first in Group B.
- c. The two winning teams in the semi-finals will play in the final match for the 1st and 2nd place, while the two losing teams will compete for the 3rd and 4th place in the semi-finals.

- d. The teams placed 3rd in each group will play under the same system for the 5th and 6th place.

8. Draw

The teams will be selected by a public draw.



9. Duration of the game

- a. Each game will last 40 minutes – two periods of 20 minutes with a 10-minute break.
- b. In the final stages (Semi-finals and Final), if the game is tied after 40 minutes, extra time will be added – 2 periods of 5 minutes (net) each – will be added. A 5-minute break will be given after the initial 40 minutes, but there will not be time break between the two periods of extra time.
- c. If the game is still tied after extra time, the winner of the game will be decided by a free kick competition from the 6-meter mark. Each team will take five kicks alternately. The team to kick first will be decided by a draw.
- d. If both teams scored the same number of goals after 5 free kicks each, the free kicks will continue until both teams have kicked an equal number of kicks and one team scored one goal more than the other.
- e. Only players who were on the field of play at the end of extra time are allowed to take part in the first five free kicks. Each kick will be taken by a different player. If the game remains undecided, the remaining players on the list will take part in the competition as well. A player is allowed to take a second kick only after all the other players on the team, including the goal keeper, have taken their kicks.
- f. Any player who was actually playing the game when it ended, including extra time, is allowed to replace the goalkeeper during the penalty kicks.

10. Referees

The Organizing Committee will select a Referees' Committee, which will appoint the referees for the competition.

11. General

- a. These regulations represent only a part of the overall rules and must be read together with the instructions outlined in the "Basic Rules and Regulations and Disciplinary Procedures" for the 15th CISM Futsal Cup for Peace 2025.
- b. In the event of any discrepancy between these Regulations and those in the "Basic Rules and Regulations", the regulations provided here will prevail and be binding. The Organizing Committee of the 15th CISM Futsal Cup for Peace 2025 will provide medals and cups for the top three teams, as well as the best player, best goalkeeper and top scorer.
