An athlete who achieves a CISM World or Continental Record shall submit to a doping control, in accordance with the current CISM anti-doping rules and the specific sports regulations is not automatically obliged to submit to doping control. <p>The CISM anti-doping commission can prioritize the testing of an athlete who achieves a CISM World or Continental Record within the scope of the Annual CISM Anti-Doping Tests Distribution Plan (TDP).</p> <p>The CISM anti-doping commission can request the Local Organizing Committee to carry out an extra TDP test when observing the real need to perform the test in an athlete who achieves a CISM World or Continental Record.</p> <p>Attention must be given when the athlete is affiliated with an International Federation and the record will impact a record of that IF. If the IF regulation requires the athlete must be tested, the procedure must be carried out so that the athlete does not have prejudice in the approval of all possible performances. The PCSC will ensure that the knowledge about these IF requirements is in the specific sports regulations.</p> 2.
