Prof. Tsolakis is currently a Professor at the School of Physical Education and Sport Science at the National and Kapodistrian University of Athens.

He holds a Bachelor's degree and a PhD in Sports Science from the National and Kapodistrian University of Athens and also conducted a Post-Doctoral Thesis with a scholarship from the State Scholarships Foundation (IKY).

His academic experience - spanning over 30 years - includes teaching at the undergraduate and postgraduate levels, supervising multiple master's and doctoral dissertations, giving numerous presentations at Seminars, publishing in national and international research journals, and co-writing three books on fencing.

Prof. Tsolakis, a former athlete who was a five-time national champion in fencing and a six-time national champion in modern pentathlon (with 35 national team participations), has over thirty years of experience working with children, cadets, junior and elite athletes on the Greek national fencing team and he also served as a fencing coach in the Olympic Games of Athens 2004, Beijing 2008 and London 2012.
