To give athletes the opportunity to prepare for the CISM World Winter Games in the best possible way, the first international training camp was held from 8th to 12th April 2019 under the professional guidance of the national coach of the DEU Para-Cross Country Skiing Team.

All in all, 11 participants from five nations (Estonia, Kazakhstan, Sweden, France and Germany) in different performance classes and disability categories took part in this training camp, who did their training units either in the "sitting class" on a special carriage or in the "standing class" on regular cross-country skis.

The highlight of the training camp was a visit to the Olympic training center in Freiburg. There the athletes had the unique opportunity to perform a running technique analysis on a treadmill specifically designed for ski rollers.
