This Training Camp is supposed to support individuals in preparing to participate in one of the offered Para-Cross Country Skiing competitions (standing & sitting) at the 4th CISM World Winter Games in 2021 (GERMANY). This week will offer professional training- & equipment-advice from experts provided by the Trainer team of the German National Paralympic Team Nordic, at the National Paralympic Center Ski Nordic in HINTERZARTEN, as well a platform for exchange of experience between the participants to join the group of CISM Para-Sport athletes.

The training program is limited to athletes with a certified physical handicap allowing an unassisted accomplishment of a Para-Ski Nordic competition at the 4th CISM WWG 2021.

For the Disability-Sport program exemption from the status of Active Duty will be made. Accepted are athletes who got wounded, injured, and/or ill during the time of military service.





3. TRANSPORTATION TO/FROM THE COMPETITION VENUE

The cost of travel to and from Germany will be the responsibility of the participating country. The organizer will ensure the transportation from the mentioned places of arrival/departure in Germany to the designated competition and will also provide transport during the conduct of the event.

4. ENTRY FORMS

Preliminary Agreement:	Not later than 1st November 2019
Final Entry:	Not later than 2 nd December 2019

- On the Final Entry Form, the participating mission shall indicate a valid and operated phone/mobile phone and fax number as well as an email address in case the organizing committee needs to contact them.
- All names mentioned in agreements must be written in Latin letters, as stated in the passport.





5. CONDITIONS OF STAY

During their stay the missions are guests of the German Federal Armed Forces. Suitable board, lodging and local transportation during the competition will be provided by the organizer.

Extra expenses such as fees for telephone calls, laundry services, additional drinks, etc. must be paid by the consumer.

Any costs associated with the stay of missions before 19th of January or after the 24th of January 2019 must be organized and paid by the respective missions.

Additional personnel will not be accepted without an official written permission of the organizer.

The cost of travel to the point of arrival and from the point of departure in Germany is solely the responsibility of the participating nation. Transportation from the points of arrival in Germany and return will be provided by the organizer.

Medical emergencies (first aid) will be the responsibility of the German Federal Armed Forces. The German Federal Armed Forces will provide medical support for all scheduled events. The German Federal Armed Forces will not be responsible for any advanced medical expenses, including hospital stays, surgical procedures, and/or other medical care beyond first aid.

All participants must travel with their own inherent medical coverage. Special medical treatment is under the responsibility of the participating nations.

6. CUSTOMS AND VISA PROCEDURES

Information concerning passports, visas and vaccinations can be obtained from the German Embassy in your country.





7. REGULATIONS

The official working language for this event is English.

8. UNIFORMS

Military dress code is not given. During class & training sessions proper training dress for cool & cold weather is applicable.

During the social event smart casual, all-weather closing is advised.

9. REQUIRED ITEMS

- Upon arrival, each athlete should provide a medical certificate about type & degree of physical disability.
- 2. If existing, official classification document, according to International Paralympic Regulations for Ski Cross Country Skiing, can be by transmitted for planning purposes via e-mail (see 12. Contacts, below), not later than the Final Entry deadline.

10. ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS

It is recommended for each athlete to bring his or her own sport equipment (especially sit ski). Individual fitting requirements in sport gear cannot be guaranteed with rental equipment at the Training Camp.

Assistance in individual customizing of personal equipment can be offered at place.

In case of exceptional problems for gearing, early contacting with the organizing team (see 12.) is advised, to find a suitable solution. Thus, we kindly ask for requests to be conveyed latest with the Final Entry deadline.

11. WEATHER INFORMATION

The temperature in January can range from an average between -10° and 5° Celsius in the FELDBERG region (Black Forest), to a daily temperature of -2° to 10° Celsius in FREIBURG IM BREISGAU. For arrival with own vehicles, make sure to adjust to possible snow conditions at higher altitude (4WD and/or snow chains).
