According to the CISM Regulations, article 7.22, competitors must be military personnel on active duty with the armed forces of their respective country with an up to date military identity card.

Civilian Mission Members are authorized (coaches, trainers, others).

According to the CISM Regulations Edition 2011, all the Orienteering CSC members are officially invited, and may be included as an extra member of their own country mission.

No other extra reserve men or women will be accepted.

4. REGULATION\$ OF THE CHAMPIONSHIP

The events will be governed by the following regulations in the latest and approved versions:

- a. CISM Guidance to Organizers Jan 2015;
- b. CISM Anti-Doping Rules Jan 2015;
- c. CISM Regulations English version 2015;
- d. CISM Orienteering Regulations 2011
- **e.** CISM Statute 2010;
- f. IOF Foot Orienteering Competitions Rule

5. UNIFORMS

Uniforms are mandatory for the opening and closing ceremonies.

Military uniforms (jacket and tie) are mandatory for official ceremonies, especially for opening ceremony and closing ceremony of the Championship.

6. REQUIRED ITEMS

It is kindly requested the delegations to bring one national flag size $0.75m \times 1.5m$ and 1 CD with the National Anthem.

7. CUSTOMS, PASSPORT, VISAS

The missions are responsible for having the necessary customs documents upon arrival in Brazil. For information on immigration requirements, please contact the Brazilian Embassy serving your country. The organizing committee is NOT responsible for:

- Hospitalizations
- Surgical operations or other special treatments
- Repatriation in case of decease by illness or accident
- Other expenses on account of illness/accident such as compensations, loss of income etc.

8. ACCESS TO THE LOCATION OF THE CHAMPIONSHIP:

Arrival and Departure

The Organization Committee of 49th World Military Orienteering Championship only provides two pickup points which are Antonio Carlos Jobim – Rio de Janeiro - International Airport (GIG) and Cabo Frio International Airport (CFB).

The Organization Committee is responsible for the round-trip local transportation from the official pick up points to the accommodation site.

Travel costs to and from Rio de Janeiro will be responsibility of the participating missions. In case of using other type of transportation, for instance, Military Aircrafts or land transportation, the delegations must inform the Organizing Committee, for the necessary arrangements.

9. CONDITIONS OF STAY

During their stay in Brazil from 17th to 123th Nov. 2016, all participating missions will be the guests of the Brazilian Armed Forces. Normal boarding, lodging and shuttle transportation between the accommodation sites and the competition sites will be provided by the Organization Committee. Early arrivals or late departures will not be accepted.

Extra expenses including telephone calls, laundry and drinks must be paid by the consumers. The expense incurred before 17th Nov. and after 23th Nov. shall be borne by respective missions.

10. MEDICAL SUPPORT

Medical emergencies (first aid) will be the responsibility of the Brazilian Organization. Routine medical care will be under the responsibility of each mission. The organizer will provide medical support during all scheduled competition. All participants must travel with their own inherent medical coverage and/or assurance.

The organizing committee is NOT responsible for:

- Hospitalizations
- Surgical operations or other special treatments
- Repatriation in case of decease by illness or accident
- Other expenses on account of illness/accident such as compensations, loss of income etc.

11. ANTI-DOPING RULES

Anti-Doping tests will be organized in accordance with the CISM anti-doping regulations. The number of tests shall be determined by the CISM Anti-Doping Commission established during

the Preliminary Meeting, according to the CISM Regulations.

The tests will be performed according to the latest WADA Anti-Doping Code and Procedures.

12. WEATHER CONDITIONS:

In mid-to-late November, the maximum local temperature is around 36°C, the minimum local temperature is 25°C, local precipitation probability is 25%, humidity is 70-80%, average wind velocity is 2-3 m/s.

13. GENERAL INFORMATION

It is mandatory that each delegation submit, along with the Final Entry, digital photos (jpeg) of all members of the delegation, as follows: 3 cm x 4 cm photo - wearing military uniform, without beret, informing name, rank (according to the table of NATO ranks) and function in the delegation.

The undersigned, Chief of Mission declare that he has read the Article 3.28. Of the CISM Policy Manual and moreover understood the following prescriptions:
A. Chief of Mission
1. Chiefs of Mission shall be familiar with CISM regulations.
2. Missions must not only participate or be present at sports events, they are also required to participate in information conferences on CISM, study days, commemorative and cultural events and ceremonies organized by the host nation.
B. Conduct of a mission
1. The Chief of Mission is responsible for the behavior of his team in sports and general discipline. He shall ensure that members of his mission respect the rules and directives prescribed by CISM and organizers of the championship. The respect of schedules is particularly important as they form the basis for the effective conduct of competitions and ceremonies. Instances of indiscipline or poor sportsmanship will be handled by Championship officials and may result in the disqualification of individual athletes or teams.
2. The Chief of Mission shall also enforce the rules concerning behavior and dress during the ceremonies. He plays an important role in promoting the CISM spirit among his mission, a spirit represented by friendly attitude towards other missions, courtesy towards organizers an. fair-play in competition. The mission, who does not wear military uniforms during the opening ceremony of a Championship, will not be authorized to take part in the Championship. The Official CISM Representative will communicate this decision.
3. In conformity with the Statutes and traditions of CISM, any political or religious action during a CISM event, in particular the dissemination of propaganda documents, pictures, brochures, reviews, etc, is strictly forbidden. Any contravention shall result in the exclusion of the mission from further competition.
