2619 years later, in 1911, during the 14th session of the International Olympic Committee in Budapest, the Modern Pentathlon was reintroduced as an olympic sport created from important military skills as fencing, swimming, horse riding, shooting and running.

The founder of the Modern Olympics, Baron Pierre de Coubertin believed, that Modern Pentathlon tested a man's moral qualities as much as his physical resources and skills, producing thereby the ideal, complete athlete.

Connecting the words of Baron Coubertin, everywhere in the world, the "complete soldiers" form a close-knit community based on joint service and camaraderie. 


1. GENERAL INFORMATION

1.1 Host City Budapest

Hungary lies in the middle of Europe, in the Carpathian Basin since its foundation, which 1100th anniversary was celebrated in 1996. Its capital is Budapest. Hungary has about 10 million inhabitants. Form of government: Republic. Countries that border Hungary are Austria, Slovakia, Ukraine, Romania, Serbia, Croatia and Slovenia. Hungary is member of the NATO since 1999 and European Union (EU) since 2004. In Hungarian the country is called "Magyarország"

Hungary's geography is defined by its two main waterways, the Danube and the Tisza. These two rivers divide the country into three sections: Dunántúl (literally "beyond the Danube" Transdanubia), Tiszántúl ("beyond the Tisza"), and Duna-Tisza köze ("between the Danube and Tisza"). Transdanubia is a primarily hilly



region which includes the very eastern stretch of the Alps (called Alpokalja), the Transdanubian Mountains in the central region, and the Mecsek and Villány Mountains (both famous for their vineyards) in the south. The northern part of the country is covered by the foothills of the Carpathians. Hungary's highest peak with its 1014 metres, The Kékes, is also found here. The country is home to the world's largest thermal water cave system and the second largest thermal lake – "Hévíz" in Hungarian, the largest lake in Central Europe – Lake Balaton – and Europe's largest natural grasslands – The Great Hungarian Plain or "Alföld" in Hungarian.






7.3 Public Transportation

8.1 Swimming

- Indoor swimming pool
- 25 meter
- 8 lanes
- The competitors and coaches can stay in the pool during the heats

8.2 Fencing

- 9+1 Piste
- Bonus Fencing

8.3 Laser Run

- The track has mainly rekortan surface and some part with grass
- One lap is 800 m
- The Laser target is ALS PLT

8.4 Riding

- According UIPM rules
- The surface is grass
- Start every 3 minutes

8.5. Doping Control

8.5.1 General Information

Doping control shall be conducted in accordance with Anti-doping Regulations under the supervision of the Hungarian Doping Control Delegate. Urine samples may be collected immediately before, and during, the Championship. Athletes selected for doping control shall be informed by anti-doping officials. Athletes will be required to sign a confirmation of notification. Athletes who are to be tested may invite a team official to accompany them to the Doping Control Centre (DCC). A selected athlete should report immediately to the DCC unless there are valid reasons for delay. All selected athletes will be accompanied by a trained chaperone of Doping Control Officer from the time of notification until arrival to the DCC. Athletes are reminded that refusal to provide a sample can render them liable to disqualification and may lead to further disciplinary action. Athletes who are required to use prescribed medication for the treatment of a medical condition should ensure that they have registered their medication, where necessary, through the Therapeutic Use Exemption system prior to attending the event.

8.5.2 Selection of Athletes





The selection of athletes for control will be made on a final position and/or random basis under the supervision of the Hungarian Doping Control Delegate. In addition, the selection of further athletes may be ordered at the discretion of the Hungarian Doping Control Delegate. Final information about the doping control will be at the Technical Meeting!

8.6 Victory Ceremonies

The victory ceremony will take place on the Award and Closing Ceremony as scheduled on the event program.


