

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### 3. COMPOSITION OF THE MISSION:

The World MAP Championship is open to military personnel in active duty form CISM member nations in active status, according to the following:

- Air force military officers /cadets on active duty;
- Other aircrew officers (other service);
- Other Air Force Military personnel could participate if requested and authorized by the Aeronautical Pentathlon PCSC prior to the competition;
- At least 2 of the team members of the nine (9) competitors named in the Composition of Mission must be educated in air navigation, both men and women are able to take part.

Civilian Mission Members are authorized (coaches, trainers, others), but all athletes must be in the military.

#### **Composition of the Missions:**

- 01 (one) Chief of Mission;
- 01 (one) Team Captain;
- 01 (one) Coach;
- 04 (four) Competitors Men;
- 03 (three) Competitors Women;
- 1 Reserve Men;
- 1 Reserve Women
- In a total of max 12 (twelve) participants.

# All the MAP CSC members are officially invited, and may be included as an extra member of their own country mission.

No other extra reserve men or women will be accepted.

Additional persons will not be accepted by the organization without explicit written request and under condition of the agreement from the Commander of the Brazilian Air Force Academy.

#### 4. ACCESS TO THE LOCATION OF THE CHAMPIONSHIP:


#### **Arrival and Departure**

All missions have to consider their flight plan to and from the Guarulhos International Airport (GRU) in São Paulo.

The organization of the 56th World Military Aeronautical Pentathlon will provide transport from Guarulhos International Airport to the Brazilian Air Force Academy.

The cost of travel to and from São Paulo will be responsibility of the participating missions.

In case of using other type of transportation, for instance, Military Aircrafts or land transportation, the delegations must inform the Organizing Committee, for the necessary arrangements.





### 5. CONDITIONS OF STAY

Regular board and lodging will be provided by the host nation for all participants during their stay in Brazil from 19<sup>th</sup> to 28<sup>th</sup> October 2014. Early arrivals or late departures will not be accepted.

Extra expenses including telephone calls, laundry and drinks must be paid by the consumers. Missions arriving before 19 October and departing after 28 October will be responsible for all board and lodging expenses.

#### 6. REGULATIONS OF THE CHAMPIONSHIP:

The competitions will be governed by CISM regulations:

- CISM Regulations Edition 2012.
- CISM Military Aeronautical Pentathlon Regulations Edition 2014.

#### 7. CONTEST INFORMATION

#### **Flying Contest**

The flying contest will be carried out with the airplane T-25 UNIVERSAL, a propeller trainer plane, used for the first flying instructions addressed to the Brazilian Air Force Cadets. The Organizing Committee will provide all the necessary information about the plane performance and the material required to plan the flying contest, as stated in the MAP regulations.

#### **Sports Contest**

**Shooting Range** – Shooting will be carried out in a 20 lanes range, with paper target and manual counting system;

**Swimming** – 50 meters pool with two lanes, left turn.

**Fencing** – A minimum of 5 pistes will be put at disposal for the event inside the Gymnasium of the Brazilian Air Force Academy. All personal equipment must be FIE approved.

**Ball** – Will be carried out in the Gymnasium of the Brazilian Air Force Academy. Warm up will be out of the Gymnasium in an uncovered basketball court.

**Obstacle Run** – The obstacles and the track distance will be informed later.

**Orienteering** – Will be carried out according to MAP regulations in the outskirts of the Brazilian Air Force Academy.

#### 8. ANTI-DOPING

Anti-doping tests will be performed in accordance with CISM anti-doping regulations.


The number of tests will be performed according to CISM Regulations.

The tests will be performed according to the latest WADA Anti-doping Code and Procedures.

#### 9. UNIFORMS

**Ceremonies:** Summer Military Uniform.

**Sports Activities:** Track Suit.





### 10. MEDICAL SUPPORT

Medical emergencies (first aid) will be the responsibility of the Brazilian Organization. Routine medical care will be under the responsibility of each mission. The organizer will provide medical support during all scheduled competition. Neither the Organization nor the Brazilian Armed Forces will be responsible for any advanced medical expenses, including hospital stays, surgical procedures, and/or other medical care beyond first aid. All participants must travel with their own inherent medical coverage and/or assurance.

#### 11. CUSTOMS AND VISA PROCEDURES:

The missions are responsible for having the necessary customs documents upon arrival in Brazil. For further information on customs and visa procedures, please contact the Brazilian Embassy in your country.

#### 12. WEATHER CONDITIONS:

The weather in October may range between  $+18^{\circ}$ C to  $+30^{\circ}$ C degrees, with 60% of air humidity.

#### 13. GENERAL INFORMATION

It is mandatory that each delegation submit, along with the Final Entry, digital photos (jpeg) of all members of the delegation, as follows: 3 cm x 4 cm photo - wearing military uniform, without beret, informing name, rank (according to the table of NATO ranks) and function in the delegation.

It is kindly requested the delegations to bring one national flag size  $0.75m \times 1.5m$  and 1 CD with the National Anthem.


