2. Goal of the Seminar

The seminar shall provide all CISM member nations the opportunity to have a qualified CISM parachuting judge for nomination to future CISM championships for 2022 and beyond. **The seminar is not valid for judge nomination to 44th WMPC 2021.**

Also, CISM parachuting judges who hold an expired license shall have the opportunity to pass the refresher test which is mandatory every 2nd year.

3. Composition of the mission

The maximum capacity of the seminar will be 20 students. The seminar will be open for two categories of students:

- Beginner students
- Refresher students

After receiving preliminary agreement from interested countries, if the number of participants exceeds the maximum number, the President of the CISM Parachuting Committee will select the students based on CISM needs as being the number of qualified judges in the respective country and the competencies of the candidates.

4. Seminar program

5. Requirements

Sufficient knowledge of English as working language, the seminar will be conducted in English only. Only CISM international licenses will be issued. Each student/judge must bring an operational and silent (no “beeps”) stopwatch that records no less than 50 splits.

5.1. Beginner students requirements

Knowledge of sport Parachuting - the students must know what happens at a parachuting competition and preferably have a background as sport parachutist and/or national/civilian parachuting judge. Students must be nominated via their national CISM Delegation.

5.2. Refresher students requirements

Refresher students must hold a CISM parachuting license.



6. Access to the location of the seminar

The location of the seminar will be at Doha.

Travelling expenses, to and from Qatar, will be the responsibility of the participating country. The organizing committee will provide transportation from the airport to the location of stay in Doha and all internal transport during the seminar.

Entry points in QATAR :

- Flight to/from HAMAD International Airport (DOH)
- By car through QATAR/SAUDI land border

7. Conditions of stay

The daily participation fee for the seminar will be 20 EUR/day to cover special tutorial expenses. (to be paid on site upon arrival)

Board and lodging will be provided by the organizing committee.

Additional food & beverage and special requirements (telephone, laundry, etc.) must be paid by the consumer.

Any costs, made before the date of arrival and/or after the date of departure, must be covered by the participants.

8. Registration

Preliminary agreement must be returned by e-mail before May 27th 2021.

Final entry must be returned by e-mail before June 27th 2021.

9. Medical support

Qatar air sports committee will take care of medical support (first aid) on site. Further costs for medical support are at the expense of the participants.

10. Dress

Dress codes:

- Opening and Closing Event: Military uniform.
- Social events: Civilian dress.
- Working dress: Sports clothing.
